I SI Partha Kumar Bhunia, O/C Manbazar PS do hereby lodge this FIR as suo-moto against (1) Amiya Ray S/O Lt- Balahari Ray of village- Mahara, (2) Jagaran Mahato S/o Lt- Padmalochan Mahato of village- Baidyanathpur, (3) Rajib Mahato S/O Rampada Mahato of village- Bandih, (4) Pallab Kalindi S/O Nimai Kalindi, of village- Bamni (5) Sanjay Haldar S/o Sadhan Haldar of village- Bamni & (6) Bikash Mahato of Pundru, all are under Manbazar PS, Dist- Purulia and 20 (Twenty) others.

I beg to state that today (12.09.2020), I was performing mobile duty along with officer and force. This refers to Manbazar PS GDE No- 441, Dtd. 12.09.2020. Accordingly, I had been to village Bamni for visit of villages at about 15.45 hrs I received an information that some supporters of BJP had blocked at Mahara More, road towards Mahara village without any prior information and permission accordingly myself along with ASI Chittaranjan Mukherjee and force rushed to the spot and found that the above noted persons under leadership of Bikash Mahato, Youth Morcha president of BJP and 20 (Twenty) others had blocked Mahara More with the Baners of BJP party on demand of immediate realese of their state leader Soumitra Khan. I asked them not to block the road and tried to convince them but they were reluctant to hear me I asked them to disperse with loud and clear voice but they did not pay any heed to my words. I also tried to convince them regarding the COVID - 19 situation, that at present Assembly of people in such a manner without maintaining Social Distance and without wearing Marks may be threat to life as the Pandemic COVID- 19 is spreading rapidly but they did not pay any heed to my request. On being asked the above accused persons could not able to give any satisfactory answer for that movement on road and blocked the public place. All the accused persons also tried negligently to spare infection of disease dangerous to life. At about 16:15 hrs. they withdrew the road blockade.

After arrival at PS I do record Manbazar PS Case No- 93 dated - 12.09.2020 U/S - 188/34 IPC as Suo-moto against (1) Amiya Ray S/O Lt- Balahari Ray of village- Mahara, (2) Jagaran Mahato S/o Lt- Padmalochan Mahato of village- Baidyanathpur, (3) Rajib Mahato S/O Rampada Mahato of village- Bandih, (4) Pallab Kalindi S/O Nimai Kalindi, of village- Bamni (5) Sanjay Haldar S/o Sadhan Haldar of village- Bamni & (6) Bikash Mahato of Pundru, all are under Manbazar PS, Dist- Purulia and 20 (Twenty) others and directed S.I. Mahadeb Rana to investigate the case.
