I SI. Sujit Das do hereby lodge this complaint as sou-moto to the effect that today(26.09.20) at around 07:45 hrs received a telephonic information that some person at Manbazar Bank more had blocked Manbazar Purulia Road (SH-5) near Manbazar PS without any prior information or permission and a huge numbers of vehicles including Public buses got obstructed. Accordingly myself as mobile duty officer rushed to the spot and found that a large numbers of vehicles were obstructed in a queue and approx 35/40 persons had blocked the road. I informed the matter to the duty Officer and he noted in GDE vide No 977 Dated.26.09.2020. The mob was unruly and the said mob was under the leadership of Soumitra @ Rana Banerjee, (30) S/O Nandagopal Banerjee, of Gopalgang PS Manbazar District Purulia. I tried to convince them but they were reluctant and obstinate to hear me. I asked them to disperse in loud and clear voice but they did not pay any heed to my words. I declared them as Unlawful Assembly but they did not care a fig. In compare to the mob we were insufficient in number to overpower them. So there was no option but to wait. We started waiting and tried to convince them to clear the road for the interest of common people but all our endeavor went in air. They were wilfully doing this blockage with intent to injuriously affect the State Highway (SH-5) causing extreme inconvenience to common people violating our order. Hence I talked with the people who had blocked the road and heard their complaints patiently and assured them that all legal steps will be taken to fulfill their demands. We also tried to convince them about the lock down situation regarding the COVID-19 that at present assembling of people in such a manner without maintaining social distancing and without wearing mask may be a threat to life as the pandemic CDVID-19 is spreading rapidly but they did not pay any heed to my request. I also tried to pacify them several times but they did not pay any heed to my request and continued road blocking till 10:15 hours causing in convenience to several passengers and people who were in the on-route buses and vehicles. It was also found that more than 20/35 different types of vehicles loaded with passengers and goods including patients, minor baby etc. were detained there from 07:45 hrs and subjected to enormous sufferings for a long time.
