Sir,

In producing herewith 05(Five) arrested accused persons namely persons 1) Sk. Injamamul Haque (23 Yrs) S/o Sk. Ahmed, 2) Sk. Syed Anwar (19 Yrs) S/o Sk. Ahmed, 3) Sk. Chotu (20 Yrs) S/o Lt. Sk. Samsul all of Vill- Sankra-B, 4) Sk Imtiaz (36 yrs) s/o Lt Sk Meraj and 5) Jamil Darji (22 Yrs) S/o Lt. Ramjan Darji both of Vill- Hariharpur all of PS – Para, Dist- Purulia.

I beg to state that today (23.09.2020), I was directed to find out whether wearing of mask by the public has been properly maintained at Para Bazar area or not. Accordingly, I had been to Para Bazar near Hospital More at about 18.15 hrs found that a gathering appeared at Para Bazar near Hospital More, none of them were wearing musk. On seeing Police party they have tried to escape from the grip of police party but some failed to escape due to efficient effort of police party. On being asked they disclosed their identity as noted above.

They violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media etc for prevention of attack from CORONA Virus/COVID-19. They are creating annoyance to the society & violated Govt. order. In view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India consolidated order No-40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) Date-24/03/2020 and further modified dated-25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 03/04/2020, 10/04/2020 & 01/05/2020. And orders of Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- 177-CS/2020 dt-18.05.2020 & 218-CS/2020 dt-30.05.2020, order No- 272-CS/2020 Dtd. 30.06.2020 and Memo no. 283-CS/2020 Dtd. 21.07.2020 and Order No- 285-CS/2020 Dtd. 30.07.2020 & Memo No- 287-CS/2020 Dtd- 03.08.2020 for complete restriction measure in wearing of mask.

I arrested them for Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued memo of arrest. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e.as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). At prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. All the process was done in between 18.35 hrs to 19.05 hrs. There was every chance of breach of peace and requiring of offence if not arrested.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be lodge against 1) Sk. Injamamul Haque (23 Yrs) S/o Sk. Ahmed, 2) Sk. Syed Anwar (19 Yrs) S/o Sk. Ahmed, 3) Sk. Chotu (20 Yrs) S/o Lt. Sk. Samsul all of Vill- Sankra-B, 4) Sk Imtiaz (36 yrs) s/o Lt Sk Meraj and 5) Jamil Darji (22 Yrs) S/o Lt. Ramjan Darji both of Vill- Hariharpur all of PS – Para, Dist- Purulia as they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to lie and violated the rule U/S 188/34 IPC and Section 51(1)(b) National Disaster Management Act- 2005 and arrange for investigation.
