I SI Gopal Bhattacharyya (49 Years) S/O- Lt. Radhashyam Bhattacharyya, Boro PS Dist- Purulia do hereby record this case as suomoto against unknown local villagers of Paradih Mouza, under Bari-Jagda G.P. P.S.- Boro Dist- Purulia and approx 150-200 unruly mob to the effect that today on 30.09.2020 at about 05:00 hours. I received information from a passenger of a bus who did not disclosed his identity regarding road blockade at Telikocha More on Manbazar – Barabazar asphalt road via Duarsini (NH-116B) under PS- Boro Dist- Purulia. I diarised the information at Boro PS GDE No. 1038 Dated-30.09.2020 at 05:05 hours. Accordingly myself along with ASI Sk. Barjahan, C/683 Mansaram Rajak, C/1481 Gadadhar Biswas and JLC/1115 Mrinmayee Mahato and LC/ 1017 Annapurna Mahato left PS for Telikocha More under PS Boro. After reaching there at about 05:45 hours. I found that the road at Telikocha More which runs between Manbazar and Barabazar via Duarsini had been blocked by 150-200 unruly mob, from 05:00 hours. They blocked the asphalt road over the issue of Notification Land of Paradih Mouza. Hence I talked with the people who had blocked the road and heard their complaints patiently and assured them that all legal steps will be taken to fulfill their demands along with the BL & LRO department. we also tried to convince them about the lock down situation regarding the COVID-19 that at present assembling of people in such a manner without maintaining social distancing and without wearing mask may be a threat to life as the pandemic COVID-19 is spreading rapidly but they did not pay any heed to my request. I also tried to pacify them several times but they did not pay any heed to my request and continued road blocking till 11.30 hours causing in convenience to several passengers and people who were in the on-route busses and vehicles. It was also found that more then 30/35 different types of vehicles loaded with passengers and goods and drivers including patients, minor baby etc. from Barabazar side and Manbazar side were detained there from 05.00 hrs and subjected to enormous sufferings for a long time. When the people assembling there turned in riotous mood and enhance their agitation vocally to a great extant the entire ambience on the road become very violent, having no other alternative way I declared the mob and commanded them to disperse accordingly but the unruly mob, causing unlawful restraint to the vehicles and passersby and thus generated danger and obstruction in public way. Meanwhile CI Manbazar and SDPO Manbazar with reinforcement and also BDO Manbazar-II, and BL & LRO Manbazar-II arrived at the spot and after prolonged discussion with the agitators, the agitators lastly withdrew the road blockade at 11:30 hrs and thereafter vehicular traffic became normal. As the unruly mob was huge in number, so immediate arrest of the unruly mob could not be effected and no lathi charge could be resorted as there was a chance of serious law & order problem. On returning to Boro PS I recorded Boro PS Case No- 61/2020 dated- 30.09.2020 U/S 188/ 34 IPC, Read with sec.18 of the west Bengal Highway Act. -1964 and sec. 51 (b) of disaster management Act. 2005 against unknown 150-200 local villagers of Paradih Mouza under P.S.- Boro Dist- Purulia and directed SI Manas Dutta to take up investigation of the case.
