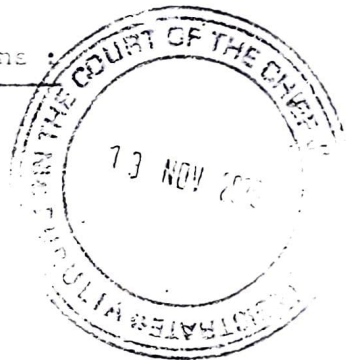

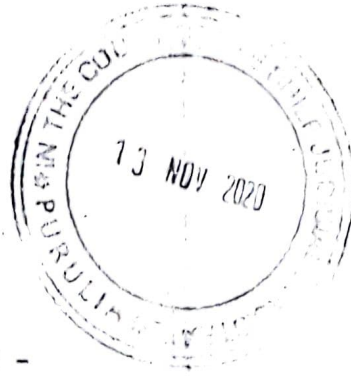

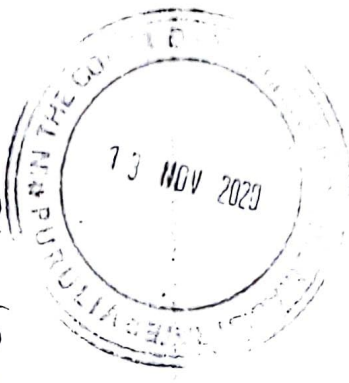

5) That most of the accused persons are the defendants in this suit and the said accused persons have appeared before the Id. Court and they have also knowledge in violation of the said injunction order. 6) That the petitioner immediately went to the Police P.S. and inform the matter to the officer-in-charge in writing on the next date but the officer did not take any action and/or did not properly enquire the facts of the incident and keep silent.

7) That the petitioner alongwith his Co-sharer visited the said tank and took photograph of the tank and also those who are catching fish from the said tank.

8) That the petitioner subsequently on 10/10/2009 filed the said complaint / petition before the Superintendent of Police, Purulia. But the Police Superintendent did not take any action till today and as such the petitioner have compell to file the present petition before this Honour's court.

9) That the said accused persons have committed for unlawful catching fishes and they have also took away the said fishes and as such they have committed theft U/s. 171 P.S. and after properly enquired the matter they should be punishable ~~according~~ according to law.

10) That the said accused persons have also violated the injunction order passed by the M.C. Civil Judge (M.C. Division) Purulia in P.S. No. 121/2017.
