Sir,

In producing herewith the arrested accused person namely Goutam Bouri @ Naru (27) S/o Tarapada Bouri of village Larubari-Bero near Bero Panchayet Office, PS – Raghunathpur, Dist.- Purulia, driver of tractor No. WB 55A/2352 and seized the tractor No. WB 55A/2352 with trolley loaded with approx 03 (three) tons steam coal. Fact of the case in brief is that on 17.12.2020 myself along with C/1474 Tushar Kanti Mondal, C/238 Dipak Bagti and C/1057 Albinas Tirkey, all of Raghunathpur PS were performing evening mobile duty in Raghunathpur PS area vide Raghunathpur PS CC No. 2765/20. At about 20:45 hrs. received a credible source information that the above noted tractor loaded with coal in a trolley was coming from Santuri side towards Raghunathpur side through Bakura – Raghunathpur pitch road (SH-8). After receiving such information I informed the matter to IC Raghunathpur PS and as per his kind direction we reached near at Madhutati More on Purulia – Bankura road (SH-8) and waiting there. At about 22:05 hrs we noticed that one tractor was coming from Santuri side. We stopped the said tractor and on searching it is found the registration no of the tractor is WB 55A/2352 and approx 03 MT steam coal was loaded in it's trolley. On asking driver of the said tractor failed to produce any papers in respect of said Steam Coal as well as papers in respect of the said tractor and trolley. He also made incoherent statement in respect of possession of the said coal which he was driving. So, it is reasonable to believe that the driver and owner of the said tractor collected the said coal either by theft or by any fraudulent means from anywhere and transporting the same to run clandestine business for wrongful gains with the help of other. On interrogation the driver of the said tractor confessed his guilt. As such it is every reason to believe that the driver and owner of the said tractor No. WB 55A/2352 and others are transporting the coal illegally. As such I arrested the accused driver of above noted tractor namely Goutam Bouri @ Naru (27) S/o Tarapada Bouri of village Larubari-Bero near Bero Panchayet Office, PS – Raghunathpur, Dist.- Purulia after observing all formalities and narrating him the ground of arrest. I also seized the tractor having registration No. WB 55A/2352 with trolley loaded with approx 03 (three) Tons steam coal under proper seizure list duly signed by the accused driver and witnesses. No public witness was available there. Approx 01 (One) K.G. of Steam Coal sealed & labeled as sample coal from major contraband.

I therefore pray before you, kindly lodge an FIR against the arrested tractor driver namely Goutam Bouri @ Naru (27) S/o Tarapada Bouri of village Larubari-Bero near Bero Panchayet Office, PS – Raghunathpur, Dist.- Purulia, owner of the tractor No. WB 55A/2352 and others as per law and arrange for its investigation.
