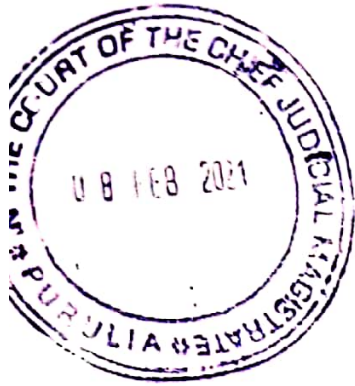

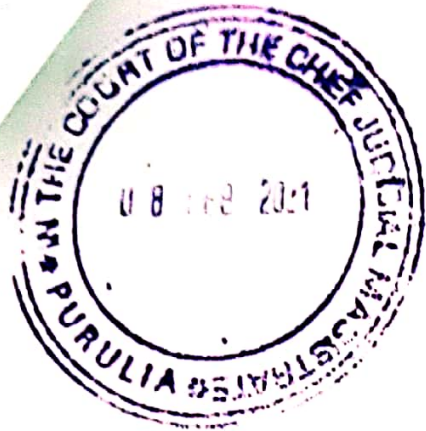

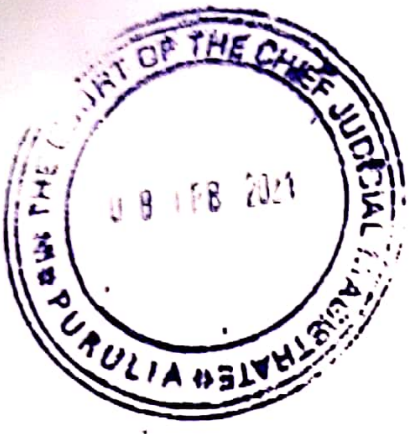
dishonestly got the deed registered though Panru Mahasto, but Panru Mahato has no right to execute the deed in favour of any one including the said Baisakhi Mahato.
