- 2. That the Complainant owned a piece of landed properties within R.S. Plot No.2464 measuring an area 33 decimals which he purchased from the previous owner on the basis of a registered Sale deed for the year 1984 & since purchase he is in possession over the same.
- 3. That like previous year this year the Complainant cultivated his land by expensing huge amount. It is to be mentioned here that the Complainant is an aged person & suffering from various ailments.

- 4. That in the last part of November, 2020, the paddy so cultivated by the Complainant within his purchased land was ready for harvesting.
- 5. That when such state of things were going on the Complainant was in search of labours for harvesting the paddy. But on 06/12/2020 at about 9 AM the Accused Persons without any right whatsoever with the help of some persons tried to cut some paddy within the aforesaid property.
- 6. That when the Complainant on hearing such information reached near his land he found that the Accused Persons were cutting some paddy within his aforesaid land. On seeing such incident the Complainant raised objection, but the Accused Persons and their men suddenly came before the Complainant and pushed him with force.
- 7. That all on a sudden the Complainant fell down on the ground and at that time the Accused Persons and their men assaulted the Complainant with feast & blows. Hearing the hue & cry some local villagers including the witnesses came near the aforesaid land when upon the Accused Persons & their men fled away with a threatening that they will forcefully took away the paddy from the said land.
- 8. That on 10/12/2020, at about 7 AM the Accused Persons forcefully harvested the paddy from the aforesaid land with intention to cause wrongful loss to the Complainant. The Complainant & Witnesses when reached the place on hearing the information, they found that the Accused Persons run away with the said paddy in their Tata Ace vehicle.
- 9. That it is to be mentioned here that the approximate weight of the stolen paddy was near about 25 maunds and amounting to be more than Rs.12,000/-. Thus the Complainant suffered a monitory loss of Rs.12,000/- for the illegal acts of the Accused Persons.
- 10. That the Complainant thereafter on several occasions informed the I/C Purulia(M) P.S. about the matter in writing but the I/C Purulia(M) P.S. did not take any action in the matter up-till now.
- 11. That the Complainant also informed the matter to the S.P. Purulia on 05/01/2021 but up-till now no action has been taken by the police. In the meantime the Accused persons are regularly threatening the Complainant with dire consequences.
- 12. That thus the Complainant brought this case for the offences committed by the Accused Persons for which they are liable to be prosecuted.

It is therefore prayed that your honour may graciously be pleased to treat this petition as a Complaint under Section-156(3) of the Cr.P.C. & send the petition to the I/C Purulia (M) P.S. for investigation & further be pleased to pass necessary order.
