Respected Sir,

In producing herewith the driver namely Sk Kalim (30 yrs) s/o Lt. Sk Mahammad of Vill- Tentlo, PS- Purulia (M), Dist- Purulia along with sand loaded (Approx 100 cft.) seized vehicle (Tractor) bearing Reg. No- WB55A/5236 attached with Seizure List, Memo of Arrest in respect of the supra person before you.


The nub of the fact in a nutshell is that on 13.02.2021 at 14:05 hrs while I, ASI Sudip Mukhopadhyay along with force i) C/2423 Siddheswar Gorain and ii) C/2239 Sonachand Pal both of Tamna PS left Tamna P.S for performing evening mobile duty vide Tamna P.S C.C No- 640/21 and GDE No- 480 dated 13.02.2021 in Tamna P.S area. During my evening mobile duty, I received a tip off at 19:25 hrs that a suspicious tractor loaded with sand was coming from Baligara Pump House side towards Baligara village under Tamna P.S. Subsequently, I along with force proceeded towards Baligara Pump House to work out the tip off. While I along with force arrived near Baligara Pump House and found that one tractor was proceeding towards Baligara village. I along with force intercepted the vehicle (Tractor) bearing Reg. No- WB55A/5236 attached with trolley loaded with sand (Approx 100 cft.) at 20:05 hrs and found that the vehicle as well as goods as identical as I received prior information. I asked the driver of the vehicle to produce the valid documents in respect of the vehicle as well as the loaded sand. But the driver of the said vehicle could not able to produce any kind of documents in respect of the tractor and the sand. I repeatedly asked the driver to produce the valid paper but he stated differently in different times. The incoherent statement of the driver purported to be a suspicious one to us. It was ascertained that the driver of the said tractor loaded the said sand in cahoots with the owner of the vehicle by illegal means for selling the same to make profit by dishonestly and he had been running a clandestine business. So it is reasoned to belief that he in cahoots with the owner of the vehicle procured the said sand from Kansai River near Baligara Pump House side by fraudulently means or theft by any means for transporting the same to run clandestine business. So I, seized the tractor bearing Reg. No- WB55A/5236 attached with trolley loaded with sand (Approx 100 cft.) under proper Seizure List in presence of available witnesses duly signed by them and also arrested the driver namely Sk Kalim (30 yrs) s/o Lt. Sk Mahammad of Vill- Tentlo, PS- Purulia (M), Dist- Purulia after informing the ground of his arrest and issued Memo of Arrest against him. Thereafter, I brought the said seized tractor to Tamna P.S.

Under the above facts and circumstances, kindly take lawful action against the driver Sk Kalim (30 yrs) s/o Lt. Sk Mahammad of Vill- Tentlo, PS- Purulia (M), Dist- Purulia and the owner of the above noted Tractor as they committed offence u/s 379/411/414 of the IPC & 21(i) (4) of Mines and Minerals (R & D) Act-1995.
