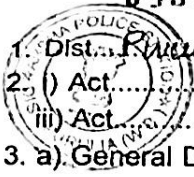

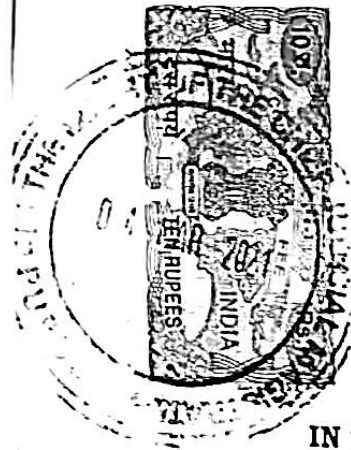

The humble complaint on behalf of the complainant u/s - 156(3) of Cr.P.C.

MOST RESPECTFULLY SHEWETH:

1. That the complainant is a permanent resident of village - Siringi, P.O. - Nekre, P.S. - Balarampur, Dist. - Purulia and the accused persons are having permanent resident of village - of village - Pitathi, P.S. - Arasha, Dist. - Purulia.
2. That the complainant got married with the accused no 1 - Subhas Murmu, son of Late Moha Murmu on 15.10.2017 as per rites and customs prevailing in their society and the marriage was negotiable one. After marriage when the complainant with lots of positive hopes stepped into her marital home at of village - Pitathi, P.S. - Arasha, Dist. - Purulia she came across with accused no 2 who happens to be her widow mother - in - law and other accused from 3 to 5 who happens to be her sister - in - laws (Nanad).
3. That at the time of marriage the father of the complainant, as per demand from the side of the bridegroom, had given Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand) and other essential articles like furnitures and other valuable utensils to the accused no 1 and his family members.
4. That after couple of months from the date of marriage the accused 2 to 5 started commenting that expectedly demanded cash dowry was not met up by the father of the complainant and on this ground they

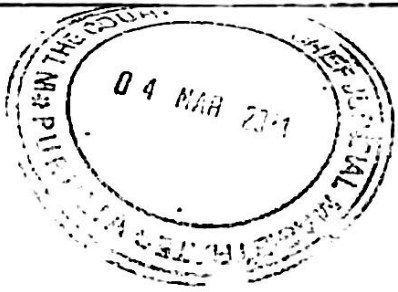

started torturing upon the complainant for demand of more cash dowry.

5. That nonetheless Petitioner felt herself in awkward situation as floating comments of caustic nature fell on her ears and she felt extremely humiliated. However for the sake of family prestige she overlooked all such humiliations and composed herself with the vow to put in all efforts to create a good bonding with her counterpart, so that they can overcome all future odds jointly.
6. That on hearing the torture upon the daughter, the father of the complainant had been to her daughter's marital home with a hope to mutate the alleged matter but the accused persons were paying no heed and clearly stated to arrange more money to the complainant's father and ultimately on 01.11.2019, the father of the complainant arranged Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand) and handed over the same to the accused person 1.
7. That after covering a year of healthy atmosphere at the marital house of the complainant again such inhuman behaviour has been started by the husband and in-laws of the complainant from the month of April, 2020 and accused no 2 to 5 had taken the lead in targeting Petitioner with caustic comments e.g. "tui aro taka niye ai tor baper kach theke. Akhon lockdown e rojgar nei. Tui taka anle khete thakte parbi na hole ber kore debo" and further they demanded Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs) from the father of the complainant

and threatened that on failure to fulfil the same, the complainant will suffer the consequence.

8. That when the complainant expressed her father's inability to fulfil the alleged more cash dowry of Rs. 2, 00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs) to the accused persons, the former caused cruelty, harassment and torture by the latter for non-fulfilment of post marriage additional dowry. Though the complainant tried to lead her conjugal life with her husband and other members and also tried to adjust herself so that she can lead her conjugal life with her husband peacefully but the complainant was subjected to various manner of physical and mental torture and also not provided with adequate foods and cloths day to day even she was not provided medical aid. As a matter of fact the degree of torture has increased day by day and the same was continuing till her final departure from matrimonial house on 02.12.2020.
9. That the complainant and her father made sincere efforts to restore their conjugal life but due to unwillingness and non-cooperative attitude of the accused no 1 (husband) coupled with the fact the other accused persons were flatly denied to keep the complainant at his house and on 02.12.2020 the complainant was finally driven out from her marital home at the instance of the husband i.e. accused no 1 coupled with other in - laws (accused no 2 to 5) and since then the petitioner has been residing at her father's house at Siringi, P.O. - Nekre, P.S. - Balarampur, Dist. - Purulia.
