Sir,

In producing herewith 06 (Six) arrested accused persons namely 1) Raban Chandra Saren (49 Yrs) S/O Lt. Gobinda Saren of Mirgi Pahari, PS-Kashipur, Dist- Purulia 2) Chaitan Bauri (26 Yrs) S/O Rabi Lochan Bauri of Indrabil, PS- Kashipur, Dist Purulia 3) Rakesh Malakar (27 Yrs) S/O Uttam Malakar of Laldanga, PS- Adra, Dist- Purulia 4) Salman Khan (36 Yrs) S/O Jabbar Khan of Kamlasthan, PS- Adra Dist- Purulia 5) Amaresh Mahato (29 Yrs) S/O Nizapada Mahato of Ranguni, PS- Adra Dist- Purulia 6) Bikke Sahis (30 Yrs) S/O Dipak Sahis of Adra Rly. Qtr No-L/49, South side near Netaji Club, PS- Adra Dist- Purulia with all connected papers.

I beg to state that today (25.04.2021), I was directed to find out whether the guidelines of Govt regarding pandemic situation has been implanted properly at Adra Bazar area or not. Accordingly, I had been to Adra Bazar near North Booking Counter along with force vide CC No-1253/21 dtd.25.04.2021 at about 16.35 hrs and found that a gathering appeared at North Booking Counter Adra Station, none of them was wearing musk. On seeing Police party they have tried to escape from the grip of police party but six failed to escape due to efficiency effort of police party. On being asked he disclosed their identity as noted above.

They violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media etc for prevention of attack from CORONA Virus/COVID-19. They are creating annoyance to the society & violated govt. order. Though in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India order No- 79-CS/2020 dated 12.04.2020 of the Government of West Bengal, Wearing of facial mask has been mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation. Whereas, vide advisory issued vide no- 715-Home (Cons)/RIM(Cons)-92/2021 dated- 17.04.21, Government of West Bengal has stressed that any violation of musk and social distance norms should be strictly dealt with.

I arrested them for disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest. Issued memo of arrest & Inspection Memo. I informed them & their relative regarding the ground of arrest i.e.as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). A prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. All the process was done in between 16.55 hrs to 17.25 hrs. There was every chance of breach of peace and requiring of offence if not arrested.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be lodge against 1) Raban Chandra Saren (49 Yrs) S/O Lt. Gobinda Saren of Mirgi Pahari, PS-Kashipur, Dist- Purulia & 05 (Five) others as above noted accd. Persons they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to lie and violated Quarantine rule U/S 188/34 IPC and Section 51(1)(b) National Disaster Management Act- 2005 and arrange for investigation.
