Today (25.04.2021) myself PSI Biswajit Chatterjee along with force were engaged in mobile duty vide Spl. C.C NO- 1075/2021, GDE No- 805 dt- 25.04.2021 and as per direction we were engaged for implementation of Govt. rules regarding violation of wearing of mask. At about 15:05 Hrs, myself along with force already been setup a Naka Checking post at Balarampur Chowk Bazar more we found 22 (twenty two) persons namely 1) Ranjit Soren (32 yrs) S/O- Doro Soren of Vill- Maitidih, 2) Jagadish Mahato (31 yrs) S/O- Atul Mahato of Vill- Shyamnagar, P.O- Supurdih, 3) Sadananda Gorai (33 yrs) S/O-Apu Gorai of Vill- Rangadih, 4) Sanjit Kundu (47 yrs) S/O- Pravash Kundu of Vill- Balarampur Chowk Bazar, 5) Sristidhar Kumar (27 yrs) S/O- Khagen Kumar of Vill- Balarampur Chowk Bazar, 6) Baikuntha Kumar (22 yrs) S/O- Radheshyam Kumar of Vill- Baraurma, 7) Jahid Ansary (45 yrs) S/O- Kalim Ansary of Vill- Haripaldih, 8) Bijoy Kumar (26 yrs) S/O- Anil Kumar of Vill- Bansgarh (Namopara), 9) Pintu Sahis (24 yrs) S/O- Darik Sahis of Vill- Ruchap, 10) Subodh Singh Sardar (38 yrs) S/O- Shankar Singh Sardar of Vill- Malti, 11) Amit Dutta (35 yrs) S/O- Haripada Dutta of Vill- Bangapattam, 12) Sumanta Dutta Modak (23 yrs) S/O- Lt. Despite of having the importance of wearing mask none of them put it on. Rather they started giving excesses for not wearing the same and tried to pass through our Police party. It is to mention worthy that rapid awareness programme through canvassing had been done since last month by the Balarampur Police Station but these people did not take care of that. Hence, there is every reason to believe that the aforesaid person came out from their home without any reason which may result in spreading of infection. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- 347-I.S.S./2M-24/2020 dated 3rd June 2020 and subsequently 79-CS/2020 dated 12.04.2020, 715-Home (Cons) RIM (Cons) -92/2021 date- 17.04.2021. Therefore they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life. Hence I arrested them after maintaining all arrest formalities regarding arrest guided by NHRC and Apex Court of India.

Under the above circumstances, I pray that a cognizable case may kindly be started against above noted 22 (twenty two) persons.
