Sir,

In producing here with 13 (Thirteen) persons namely (i) Sajal Sing Sardar (19 Yrs) S/o- Lt. Badal Sing Sardar of Vill- Nilmoanpur (ii) Dackter Mahato (26 Yrs) S/o- Kalipada Mahato of Vill- Porsa (iii) Binod Mahato (23 Yrs) S/o- Subhas Mahato of Vill- Kukurchari (iv) Ashok Kumar Mahato (29 Yrs) S/o- Suryanarayan Mahato of Vill- Kharipahari (v) Buddheswar Mahato (20 Yrs) S/o- Sahadeb Mahato of Vill- Bansbera (vi) Abhilas Mahato (54 Yrs) S/o- Lt. I beg to state that on (27.04.2021), I was directed to find out whether the COVID protocol has been implanted properly at Barabazar Market area or not. This refers to Barabazar PS GDE No- 1276 Dtd. 27.04.2021. Accordingly, myself along with available officers & force had been to market area at about 16.45 hrs. At around 18.05 hrs I found that a gathering appeared in Barabazar Namopara bypass without wearing of face mask and seen the Police party some of them tried to fled away. After that as per order we detained the above noted persons.

I introduced myself and ask for their identity. They disclosed their identity as noted above. On interrogation these persons stated their identification but failed to give any satisfactory answer for their such act of violating govt orders. I asked them reason for none wearing of mask in Covid-19 pandemic situation. They failed to explain any valid reason for non-wearing of mask in spite of govt. order in public places. Their negligent act likely to spread infection of disease, dangerous to life of human being. All 13 (Thirteen) persons also failed to give satisfactory answer for such type of movement in indiscipline manner. They violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media etc for prevention of attack from CORONA Virus/COVID-19. They are creating annoyance to the society & violated the Government order **vide Memo No- 486-CS/2021 Dtd. 24.04.2021** of the Govt. of WB.

Accordingly, I arrested them for Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant; after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued memo of arrest. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e. as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). At prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. They also violated the norms of disaster management.

All the process was done in between 18.15 hrs and 18.45 hrs. There was every chance of breach of peace and requiring of offence if not arrested. As there was pandemic situation in the town the peoples left the place and did not agreed to come forward to remain present as witness in the process. I also refrained myself from encouraging much people to come out from home to remain present in the Police work in this time of Lock Down.

After that we left for PS. On arrival at PS I type this letter of complaint at our PS computer and submitted to I.C Barabazar PS through duty officer ASI Manas Kumar Pan for taking necessary action as per law. I handed over all the relevant papers, Arrest Memos.
