Sir,

In producing here with 07(Seven) arrested accused persons namely (1) Prasanta Mahato (32) S/O Subhash Mahato of village Benchabani PS Manbazar District Purulia, 2. Debraj Mahato (20) S/O Bharat Mahato of village Chirugora, PS Boro District Purulia, 3. Santosh Bauri (39) S/O Lt. Fatu Bauri of village Kahalpara PS Manbazar District Purulia, 4. Bijoy Bauri (19) S/O Kanti Bauri of village Mochakuli, PS Manbazar District Purulia, 5. Ajoy Majhi (26) S/O Subhas Majhi of village Bankata, PS Manbazar District Purulia, 6. Sujit Ruhidas (33) S/O Ranjit Ruhidas of village Chirugora PS Bandwan District Purulia, 7. Akal Ruhidas (46) S/O Motilal Ruhidas of village Madhopur, PS Manbazar District Purulia.

I beg to state that today (24.04.2021), I was directed to find out whether the lock down has been implanted properly at Manbazar Market area or not. This refers to Manbazar PS GDE No- 979 Dtd. 24.04.2021. Accordingly, I had been to market area side no one is listening dispute mike pesching in the area. The above noted persons walking freely in the public streets without wearing a mask. They are not following the roles and regulations of Corona disease at about- 16:15 hrs I found that the above noted persons were roaming aimlessly at bazaar area. Myself along with force detained them at Manbazar post office more under Manbazar PS. On being asked the above accused persons could not able to give any satisfactory answer for that movement on road and public place. Though lockdown is going on throughout the District of Purulia in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India consolidated order No- 40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) Date-24/03/2020 and further modified dated-25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 03/04/2020 & 10/04/2020, and further notification dated 17.04.21 Govt of West Bengal vide No. 715- Home (Cons)/RIM(Cons)- 92/2021. for complete restriction measure. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- H & F W/120/20 dated 22.03.2020 which is extended till now. Moreover all the detained persons were refuses to comply the direction given by the Central Govt. & State Govt. to combat the severity of COVID-19 pandemic. All the accused persons also tried negligently to spare infection of disease dangerous to life.

I arrested them for Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued memo of arrest & Inspection Memo. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e. as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). At prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. More over they driven the motor cycle on public way in rush and negligently as to endanger to human life. On being asked they did not produce the valid documents in respect of said motor cycle as well as driving license.
