Today (01.05.2021) myself SI Prasanta Kr. Shit along with force were engaged in mobile duty vide Spl. C.C NO- 1018/2021, GDE No- 18 dt-01.05.2021 and as per direction we were engaged for implementation of Govt. rules regarding violation of wearing of mask. At about 17:05 Hrs, myself along with force already been setup a Naka Checking post at Balarampur Chowk Bazar more we found 12 (twelve) persons namely 1) Pintu Ansari (28 yrs) S/O- Lt. Mustak Ansari of Vill- Station Para, 2) Achintya Kumar (27 yrs) S/O- Gour Kumar of Vill- Tentlow, 3) Haradhan Paramanik (32 yrs) S/O- Lt. Tarapada Paramanik of Vill- Bansgarh, 4) Dinesh Mahato (25 yrs) S/O- Prahlad Mahato of Vill- Nekre, 5) Nityananda Gope (26 yrs) S/O- Sukdev Gope of Vill- Rapkata, 6) Bidyasagar Dey (52 yrs) S/O- Lt. Prakash Ch. Dey of Vill- Rangadih, 7) Sujoy Kumar (26 yrs) S/O- Ishan Kumar of Vill- Rangadih, 8) Debasish Kumar (26 yrs) S/O- Methar Kumar of Vill- Kalitala, 9) Surjanarayan Murmu (20 yrs) S/O- Sanjoy Murmu of Vill- Kana, 10) Kalipada Kaibortya (37 yrs) S/O- Lt. Binoy Kaibortya of Vill- Kalitala, 11) Paresh Gorai (23 yrs) S/O- Kamal Gorai of Vill- Rangadih, 12) Ganesh Paramanik (35 yrs) S/O- Santosh Paramanik of Vill- Bangapattam, all of P.S- Balarampur, Dist.- Purulia were moving aimlessly. Despite of having the importance of wearing mask none of them put it on. Rather they started giving excuses for not wearing the same and tried to pass through our Police party. It is to mention worthy that rapid awareness programme through canvassing had been done since last month by the Balarampur Police Station but these people did not take care of that. Hence, there is every reason to believe that the aforesaid person came out from their home without any reason which may result in spreading of infection. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- 347-I.S.S./2M-24/2020 dated 3rd June 2020 and subsequently 79-CS/2020 dated 12.04.2020, 715-Home (Cons) RIM (Cons) -92/2021 date- 17.04.2021 and also order No- 403/2020-DM-I(A) dated-29.04.2021. Therefore they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life. Hence I arrested them after maintaining all arrest formalities regarding arrest guided by NHRC and Apex Court of India.

Under the above circumstances, I pray that a cognizable case may kindly be started against above noted 12 (twelve) persons.
