Sub: Prayer for lodged FIR

Sir,
In producing here with 10 (Ten) persons namely (1) Suresh Ch. Mahato (35 Yrs) S/o- Sitaram Mahato of Vill- Ragma (2) Dipak Kr. Modak (37 Yrs) S/o- Kamal Kar Modak Vill- Barabazar (3) Prasenjit Kundu Modak (26 Yrs) S/o- Lt. Sankar Kundu Modak of Vill- Barabazar (4) Bishnu Kar Modak (33 Yrs) S/o- Nandalal Kar Modak of Vill- Barabazar (5) Nanda Kar Modak (58 Yrs) S/o- Lt. Probod Kar Modak of Vill- Barabazar (6) Sushil Singha Deb (49 Yrs) S/o- Lt. Janardan Singha Deb of Vill- Barabazar Rajapara (7) Laltu Kar Modak (23 Yrs) S/o- Kamal Kar Modak of Vill- Barabazar (8) Rasaraj Mahato (59 Yrs) S/o- Lt. I beg to state that today (17.05.2021), I was directed to find out whether the COVID protocol has been implanted properly at Barabazar Market area or not. This refers to Barabazar PS GDE No- 809 Dtd. 17.05.2021. Accordingly, I had been to market area at about 16.45 hrs. At around 20.45 hrs I found that a gathering appeared at Barabazar Chawk Bazar without mask and seen the Police party some of them tried to fled away. After that as per order we detained the above persons.

I introduced myself and ask for their identity. They disclosed their identity as noted above. On interrogation these persons stated their identification but failed to give any satisfactory answer for their such act of violating govt orders. I asked them reason for none wearing of mask in Covid-19 pandemic situation. They failed to explain any valid reason for non-wearing of mask in spite of govt. order in public places. Their negligent act likely to spread infection of disease, dangerous to life of human being. All 10 (Ten) persons also failed to glve satisfactory answer for such type of movement in indiscipline manner. They violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media etc for prevention of attack from CORONA Virus/COVID-19. They are creating annoyance to the society & violated govt order **vide Order vide Memo No- 486-CS/2021 Dtd. 24.04.2021 & Order No- 647/ISS/2M-22/2020 Dtd. 15.05.2021 of the Govt. of WB.**

Accordingly, I arrested them for Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant; after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued memo of arrest. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e. as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). At prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. More over they driven the vehicle on public way in rush and negligently as to endanger human life. They also violated the norms of disaster management.

All the process was done in between 21.05 hrs and 21.35 hrs. There was every chance of breach of peace and requiring of offence if not arrested. As there was pandemic situation in the town the peoples left the place and did not agreed to come forward to remain present as witness in the process. I also refrained myself from encouraging much people to come out from home to remain present in the Police work in this time of Lock Down.

After that I left for PS. On arrival at PS I type this letter of complaint at our PS computer and submitted to I.C Barabazar through duty officer SI Sajal Kantil Panda for taking necessary action as per law. I handed over all the relevant papers, Arrest Memos.
