Sir,

In producing here with 11(Eleven) arrested accused persons namely 1. Sachin Lohar (23) S/O Sadhan Lohar of village Charki, PS Manbazar District Purulia, 2. Bapi Bauri (27) S/O Satish Bauri of village Manbazar Upurpara, PS Manbazar District Purulia, 3. Atanu Bauri (22) S/O Naru Bauri of village - Muchai Kuli Manbazar, PS Manbazar District Purulia, 4. Ajoy Bauri (40) S/O Lt. Sankar Bauri of village Muchaikuli Manbazar, PS Manbazar District Purulia, 5. Bhakta Binod Halder (38) S/O Swapna Kumar halder of village- Khatra (rankanjitola) PS Khatra, District Bankura, 6. Sahadeb Bauri (55) S/O Lt. Karali Bauri of village- Jorberia, PS Manbazar District Purulia, 7. Sisir Bauri (27) S/O Helu Bauri of village- Narakuli Manbazar, PS Manbazar District Purulia, 8. Nemai Dutta (32) S/O Lt Rabi Duitta of village- Poddarpura Manbazar, PS Manbazar District Purulia, 9. I beg to state that today (06.05.2021), I was directed to find out whether the lock down has been implanted properly at Manbazar Market area or not. This refers to Manbazar PS GDE No- 183 Dtd. 06.05.2021 . Accordingly, I had been to market area side no one is listening dispute mike peshing in the area. The above noted persons walking freely in the public streets without wearing a mask. They are not following the rules and regulations of Corona disease at about 14:25 hrs I found that the above noted persons were roaming aimlessly at bazaar area. Myself along with force detained them at Manbazar Hts Stand under Manbazar PS. On being asked the above accused persons could not able to give any satisfactory answer for that movement on road and public place. Though lockdown is going on throughout the District of Purulia in view of Pandemic of COIVD-19 outbreak vide Govt of India consolidated order No-40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) Date-24/03/2020 and further modified dated-25/03/2020, 27/03/2020, 02/04/2020, 03/04/2020 & 10/04/2020, and further notification dated 17.04.21 Govt of West Bengal vide No- 715- Home (Cons)/RIM(Cons)- 92/2021. for complete restriction measure. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Order No- H & F W/120/20 dated 22.03.2020 which is extended till now. Moreover all the detained persons were refuses to comply the direction given by the Central Govt. & State Govt. to combat the severity of COVID-19 pandemic. All the accused persons also tried negligently to spare infection of disease dangerous to life.

I arrested them for Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued memo of arrest & Inspection Memo. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e. as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). At prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention.

All the process was done in between 14:25 hrs and 15:45 hrs. There was every chance of breach of peace and requiring of offence if not arrested. As there was lock down in the town the peoples left the place and did not agreed to come forward to remain present.
