In producing herewith 06 (Six) arrested accused persons namely 1) Sk. Abul (59 Yrs) S/o Sk. Elahi of Vill-Gurguria, 2), Nurshed Ansary (37) S/o Nurmohammad Ansary of Vill- Raherdih, 3) Hakim Ansary (38) S/o Nurmohammad Ansary of Vill-Raherdih, 4) Sabir Ansary (32) S/o Idrish Ansary of Vill-Raherdih all of PS-Para, 5) Bholanath Swarnakar (35) S/o Netai Swarnakar of Vill-Panjania, PS-Hura and 6) Debasish Singh (21) S/o Subhash Singh of Vill- Amchatar, PS- Santaldih all of Dist- Purulia. I beg to state that today (11.05.2021), I was directed to find out whether wearing of mask by the public has been properly maintained at Dubra Bazar area or not. Accordingly, I had been to Dubra Bazar near Durga Mandir at about 14.35 hrs and found that a gathering appeared at Dubra Bazar near Durga Mandir, none of them were wearing mask. On seeing Police they have tried to escape from the grip of police party but some failed to escape due to efficient effort of Police. On being asked they disclosed their identity as noted above.

In this pandemic situation of CORONA Virus/COVID-19 the above noted persons violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media by strolling, riding without mask instead of follow the COVID rules of wearing mask. They are creating annoyance to the society & violated Govt. order ref. Advisor issued by the Additional Chief Secretary, Govt. of West Bengal vide No- 715 Home (Cons)/RIM (Cons)-92/2021 Dtd- Howrah, the 17th April, 2021 for complete restriction measure. So, I arrested them for Disobedience of order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued memo of arrest. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e.as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). At prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. All the process was done in between 14.45 hrs to 15.55 hrs. There was every chance of breach of peace and requiring of offence if not arrested.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be lodge against 1) Sk. Abul (59 Yrs) S/o Sk. Elahi of Vill-Gurguria, 2), Nurshed Ansary (37) S/o Nurmohammad Ansary of Vill-Raherdih, 3) Hakim Ansary (38) S/o Nurmohammad Ansary of Vill-Raherdih, 4) Sabir Ansary (32) S/o Idrish Ansary of Vill-Raherdih all of PS-Para, 5) Bholanath Swarnakar (35) S/o Netai Swarnakar of Vill- Panjania, PS- Hura and 6) Debasish Singh (21) S/o Subhash Singh of Vill- Amchatar, PS- Santaldih all of Dist- Purulia as they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to lie and violated the rule U/S 188/34 IPC and Section 51(b) National Disaster Management Act- 2005 and arrange for investigation.
