In producing herewith 10 (Ten) arrested accused persons namely 1) Sanjoy Bauri (25) S/o Kintu Bauri of Vill- Fusrabaid, 2) Ranit Kumar Hari (19) S/o Rajib Kumar Hari of Vill- Anara Banglow side, 3) Rajib Roy (18) S/o Pannalal Roy of Vill- Bagalia, 4) Balai Rajwar (23) S/o Jiten Rajwar of Vill- Asanbani, 5) Pradip Bauri (24) S/o Sadhan Bauri of Vill- Palma, 6) Biswanath Bauri (24) S/o Manbhula Bauri of Vill- Palma, 7) Sadhan Bauri (21) S/o Ramkrishna Bauri of Vill- Palma, 8) Anath Majee (45) S/o Lt- Pravakar Majee of Vill- Fulirdih, 9) Subhendu Kaibarta (46) S/o Lt- Sitaram Kaibarta of Vill- Jabarra, all of PS Para, 10) Laltu Gorain (31) S/o Lt- Bhujanga Gorain of Vill- Dumarakuli, PS- Adra, all are Dist.- Purulia. I beg to state that today (28.05.2021), I was directed to find out whether wearing of mask by the public has been properly maintained at Anara bus stand area or not. Accordingly, I had been to Anara bus stand under Anara OP at about 16.25 hrs found that a gathering appeared at Anara bus stand, none of them were wearing mask. On seeing Police they have tried to escape from the grip of police party but some failed to escape due to efficient effort of Police. On being asked they disclosed their identity as noted above.


In this pandemic situation of CORONA Virus/COVID-19 the above noted persons violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media by strolling, riding without mask instead of follow the COVID rules of wearing mask. They are creating annoyance to the society & violated Govt. order ref. Advisor issued by the Additional Chief Secretary, Govt. of West Bengal vide No- 715 Home (Cons)/RIM (Cons)- 92/2021 Dtd- Howrah, the 17th April, 2021 for complete restriction measure. So, I arrested them for Disobedience of order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued memo of arrest. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e. as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). At prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. All the process was done in between 16.35 hrs to 17.05 hrs. There was every chance of breach of peace and requiring of offence if not arrested.
