Sir,

I, SI Subrata Patra S/O Shri Bimal Patra of Vill. Ishabpur, P.S Belda, Dist. Paschim Medinipur do hereby produce (1) Umapada Gorai (50 yrs) S/O-Lt. Iswar Chandra Gorai (2) Ranjit Gorai (42 Yrs) S/O- Santosh Gorai both of Vill- Sadhusaltora, PS-Santuri, Dist. Purulia, (3) Manas Mal (32 yrs) S/O- Haru Mal (4) Kirtan Mal (45 Yrs) S/O- Panu Mal (5) Naru Mal (36 Yrs) S/O- Panu Mal all are Vill- Kulurdanga, PS-Santuri, Dist. Purulia (6) Rabin Mandal (26 Yrs) S/O- Banshi Mandal of Vill- Balitora, PS-Santuri, Dist- Purulia & do hereby lodge a written complaint against them, to the effect that today on 09.05.2021 while I along with C/1155 Jagannath Jha & NVF/393 Sabyasachi Mahato of Santuri PS as per direction engaged in evening mobile duty within Santuri PS area. (Reference Santuri P.S.G.D.I. No. 322 dtd. 09.05.2021 vide C.C. No. 1358/21 dtd. 09.05.2021) for implementation of Government rules regarding Disaster Management Plan. On 09.05.2021 while we returning from Rambhattadih side under Santuri P.S jurisdiction and reached at Sadhusaltora Morh through Raghunathpur-Saltora Road at about 16:40 hrs. found that the above noted 06(Six) persons were gossiping near Sadhusaltora Morh without wearing a mask and maintaining social distancing which violates the compliance of norms of wearing of mask and maintaining social distancing during this pandemic situation in c/w COVID-19. So, there is every reason to believe that the above noted persons were moving without wearing a mask and maintaining social distancing which violates the compliance of norms of wearing of mask during this pandemic situation and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Government rule (Memo No. 486-CS/2021 Dated- 24th April 2021Government of West Bengal 'Nabanna' 325, Sarat Chatterjee Road Howrah- 711102). So, I have arrested them maintaining all legal formalities as well as notifying the ground of arrest and informed their family members through local people.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be started against accused (1) Umapada Gorai (50 yrs) S/O-Lt. Iswar Chandra Gorai (2) Ranjit Gorai (42 Yrs) S/O- Santosh Gorai both of Vill- Sadhusaltora, PS-Santuri, Dist. Purulia, (3) Manas Mal (32 yrs) S/O-Haru Mal (4) Kirtan Mal (45 Yrs) S/O- Panu Mal (5) Naru Mal (36 Yrs) S/O- Panu Mal all are Vill- Kulurdanga, PS-Santuri, Dist. Purulia (6) Rabin Mandal (26 Yrs) S/O- Banshi Mandal of Vill- Balitora, PS-Santuri, Dist- Purulia under proper sec. of law as they disobeyed/Ignored Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Government rule and arrange for its investigation.
