Sub: Request for lodging F.I.R. against arrested accused persons 1) Santigopal Majee (35yrs) S/o Lokesh Majee of Vill- Kelyahi, PS- Para, 2) Bijay Mahato (22yrs) S/o Lt- Ashoke Mahato of Vill- Kalajore, PS Kashipur, 3) Jagannath Sen (30yrs) S/o Nandalal Sen of Vill- Barrah, PS- Raghunathpur, all of Dist- Purulia.

Sir,

In producing herewith 03 (Three) arrested accused persons namely 1) Santigopal Majee (35yrs) S/o Lokesh Majee of Vill- Kelyahi, PS- Para, 2) Bijay Mahato (22yrs) S/o Lt- Ashoke Mahato of Vill- Kalajore, PS Kashipur, 3) Jagannath Sen (30yrs) S/o Nandalal Sen of Vill- Barrah, PS- Raghunathpur, all of Dist- Purulia. I beg to state that today (28.06.2021), I was directed to find out whether wearing of mask by the public has been properly maintained at Chapuri More area or not and also to observed Lock down protocol at night from 09.00 PM to 05.00 AM. Accordingly, I had been to Chapuri More area at about 21.35 hrs and found that a gathering appeared at Chapuri More, none of them were wearing mask. On seeing Police they tried to escape from the grip of police party but some failed to escape due to efficient effort of Police. On being asked they disclosed their identity as noted above.

In this pandemic situation of CORONA Virus/COVID-19 the above noted persons violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media by strolling, riding without mask instead of following the COVID rules of wearing mask and not to stroll after 09.00 PM as there is complete lockdown after 09.00 PM to 05.00 AM. They are creating annoyance in that locality & violated Govt. order ref. Advisor issued by the Additional Chief Secretary, Govt. of West Bengal vide No- 715 Home (Cons)/RIM (Cons)-92/2021 Dtd- Howrah, the 17th April, 2021 for complete restriction measure. So, I arrested them for Disobedience of order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued memo of arrest. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e.as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act and released them on bail. At prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. All the process was done in between 21.45 hrs to 22.05 hrs.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be lodge against 1) Santigopal Majee (35yrs) S/o Lokesh Majee of Vill- Kelyahi, PS- Para, 2) Bijay Mahato (22yrs) S/o Lt- Ashoke Mahato of Vill- Kalajore, PS Kashipur, 3) Jagannath Sen (30yrs) S/o Nandalal Sen of Vill- Barrah, PS- Raghunathpur, all of Dist- Purulia as they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to lie and violated the rule.
