Sub: Request for lodging FIR against arrested accused persons.

Sir,

With due respect I beg to submit before you that on 10/06/2021 at about 18:55 hrs. while I, SI Subhash Malik along with C/844 Tufan Swadagar and C/638 Lalehand Bag were engaged on mobile duty in Raghunathpur Town area and found the following persons were moving at Raghunathpur Traffic More aimlessly and not wearing mask in this pandemic situation and violation of social distancing, as such I detained them on that spot. On being asked the following persons could not able to give any satisfactory answer for that moving aimlessly without mask in this pandemic situation and violation of social distancing. As such the following persons violated the order during the pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of WB in c/w Corona virus/Covid-19 vide No. 647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated- 15.05.2021 of Chief Secretary, West Bengal, Memo No. 486-CS/2021 dated- 24.04.2021 and Order No. 79-CS/2020 dated- 12.04.2020 and they are responsible for their negligent Act and malignant Act likely to spread infection of disease dangerous to life. Moreover, all the detained persons were making and circulating false alarm or warning as to disaster or its severity or magnitude, leading to panic among people and as well as the society. Accordingly the following persons were arrested after maintaining all the formalities regarding their arrest and brought them to PS.

- 1) Rajesh Mukhi (30) S/o Binoy Mukhi of Palashkola, PS – Adra, Dist.- Purulia.
- 2) Mangal Nayak (27) S/o Ajit Nayak of Tagore Colony, Palashkola, PS – Adra, Dist.- Purulia.
- 3) Tarun Kumar Rajak (50) S/o Lt. Bharat Chandra Rajak of Raghunathpur, Ward No 1, PS – Raghunathpur, Dist.- Purulia.
- 4) Rajen Majhi (24) S/o Late Kalipada Majhi of Vill.- Beldanga, PS – Raghunathpur, Dist.- Purulia.
- 5) Ganesh Malakar (34) S/o Sebhana Malakar of Vill.- Panchudanga, PS – Adra, Dist.- Purulia.
- 6) Ashim Majee (33) S/o Late Harekrishna Majee of Vill.- Gobindapur, PS – Raghunathpur, Dist.- Purulia.

Hence it is prayed before you that a specific case may kindly be lodged against the above mentioned persons under proper section of law.
