Sub: Prayer for lodged FIR

Sir,

In producing here with 10 (Ten) arrested persons namely (1) Narayan Mahato (19 Yrs) S/o-Tarani Mahato of Vill- Metyala (2) Shyamal Mahato (25 Yrs) S/o- Bauri Mahato of Vill- Muradih (3) Satya Kar Modak (42 Yrs) S/o- Lt. Fanibhusan Kar Modak of Vill- Madhya Barabazar (4) Uttam Kr. Mahato (19 Yrs) S/o- Samir Mahato of Vill- Bodaldih (5) Bhim Mahato (25 Yrs) S/o- Sristidhar Mahato of Vill- Bankati (6) Dilip Mahato (22 Yrs) S/o- Binanda Mahato of Vill- Metyala (7) Anath Mahato (26 Yrs) S/o- Niranjan Mahato of Vill- Durku (8) Jagannath Mahato (35 Yrs) S/o- Lt. Radhanath Mahato of VIII- Bansbera all are of PS- Barabazar, Dist- Purulia (9) Durgacharan Gorai (26 Yrs) S/o- Sasadhar Goral & (10) Swapan Kr. Mahato (42 Yrs) S/o- Bharat Mahato both of Vill-Mukrudih, PS- Boram, Dist- East Singhbhum, Jharkhand along with memo of arrest and other relevant papers.

I beg to state that on (21.07.2021), myself along with the officers and force were directed to find out whether the COVID protocol has been implanted properly at Barabazar Market area or not. This refers to Barabazar PS GDE No- 1156 Dtd. 21.07.2021. Accordingly, we went to the market area at about 17.35 hrs. At around 18.15 hrs we found that a gathering appeared at Barabazar Jaltanki morh under Barabazar PS without wearing face masks and saw the Police party some of them tried to flee away. After that we detained the above noted persons.

I introduced myself and asked for their identity. They disclosed their identity as noted above. On interrogation these persons were stated their identification but failed to give any satisfactory answer for their such type of act for violating govt orders. I asked them the reason for non wearing face masks in Covid-19 pandemic situation. They failed to explain any valid reason for non-wearing of masks in spite of the government order in public places. Their negligent act is likely to spread infection of disease, dangerous to the life of human beings. All 10 (Ten) persons also failed to give satisfactory answers for such type of movement in an indiscipline manner. They violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media etc for prevention of attack from CORONA Virus / COVID-19. They are creating annoyance to the society & violating the qovt order vide Memo No- 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 Dtd. 14.07.2021 of the Govt. of WB.

Accordingly, I arrested them for Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant; after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued memo of arrest. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e. as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). At prima facie there was sufficient evidence to secure their detention. They also violated the norms of disaster management.

All the process was done in between 18.15 hrs and 19.15 hrs. There was every chance of creating breach of peace and requiring offence if not arrested. As there was a pandemic situation in West Bengal the people left the place and did not agree to come forward to remain present as witness in the process. I also refrained myself from encouraging many people to come out from home to remain present in the Police work in this time of Lock Down.

After that I left for PS. On arrival at PS I typed this letter of complaint at our PS computer and submitted it to I.C Barabazar through duty officer LSI Ranjita Mahata for taking necessary parties as per law. I handed over all the relevant papers, Arrest Memos.
