In producing herewith, the 12 (Twelve) persons namely 1. Kashinathnath Majhi (26) S/O Nityananda Majhi of Vill- Bandulohar (Kalma), PO- Mahatomara, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 2. Pratham Karmakar (22) S/O Rampada Karmakar of Vill- madhupur, PO-Brajapur, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 3. Sitesh Majhi (43) S/O Babulal Majhi of Vill- Bandulohar (Kalma), PO- Mahatomara, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 4. Pushu Karmali (29) S/O Gera Karmali of Vill- Gorla, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 5. Anil Gorain (32) S/O Indrajit Gorain of Vill- Kulagutu, PO- Thakursima, PS-Arsha, Dist-Purulia 6. Amarjit Laya (19) S/O Gouranga Laya of Vill + PO- Ichag, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 7. The fact of the case in a nut shell is that I SI Asoke Kr. Sen along with force namely (i) C/386-Sibendu Sinha, (ii) C/611-Jitandranath Pathak were performing the raid duty against the night lock down at Birsa More under Jhalda PS. Subsequently I along with force arrived at spot at 21:05 hrs. for the implementation of the Govt Order regarding the night restriction. This refers to Jhalda PS GDE No 1069 dtd. 24.07.2021 in consonance with C.C No 2001/21 Dtd. 24.07.2021. During the naka duty at Birsa More, I intercepted the above noted 12 (Twelve) persons noted in the supra (Sl no 1-12), who were loitering aimlessly without wearing the mask and not maintaining the social distance. On being asked they could not give sufficient reason or satisfactory answer of their unwarranted loitering after violating the Government order in this pandemic situation. Consequently, it reasoned to believe that they violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dtd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 15/05/2021 and Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dtd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd. 14.07.21. Consequently, the supra noted persons were arrested on the spot and informed them the ground of their arrest and issued memo of arrest in respect of them.

As the supra noted persons violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dtd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 15/05/2021 and Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dtd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd. 14.07.21. Ergo, they can be booked U/S 188 of the IPC and 51 (1) (b) of the Disaster Management Act 2005 and read with section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act. 1897. Ergo a specific case may kindly be initiated against them and arranged for its investigation.
