

Aswani Goswami (35) S/o Ramkrishna Das Goswami of Magha, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 4. Tarani Mahato (38) S/o Late Niranjan Mahato of Darpa, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 5. Mohit Mahato (18) S/o Bipin Chandra Mahato of Chotupad, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 6. Thakurdas Mahato (20) S/o Rashraj Mahato of Rangradih, Ghorabandha, PS-Bagmundi, Dist-Purulia, 7. The fact of the case in a nut shell is that today i.e. on 26/07/2021, I SI Jayanta Kr. Chakraborty along with force namely (i) JC/1507 Jalim Tudu (ii) JC/1464 Monjosh Bhagat, (iii) HG/1826 Apurba Singh Sardar, all of Tulin OP were performing mobile duty as well as Naka duty at Maru more on Jhalda-Ranchi road from 17:15 hrs for the implementation of the Govt. Order regarding all to wear Mask. This refers to Tulin OP under Jhalda PS GDE No 716 dtd 26.07.2021 in consonance with C.C No 969/21 Dtd. 26.07.2021. During the Naka duty at Maru more, I intercepted the following above noted 10 (Ten) persons noted in the supra (SI no 1-10), who were loitering aimlessly without wearing the mask and not maintaining the social distance. On being asked they could not give sufficient reason or satisfactory answer of their unwarranted loitering after violating the Government Order in this pandemic situation. Consequently, it reasoned to believe that they violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dt 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dt 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dt 15/05/2021, Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dt. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dt. 14.07.21. Consequently, the supra noted persons were arrested on the spot and informed them the ground of their arrest and issued memo of arrest in respect of them.

As the supra noted persons violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dt 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dt 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dt 15/05/2021 and Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dt. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dt. 14.07.21. Ergo, they can be booked U/S 188 of the IPC and 51 (1) (b) of the Disaster Management Act 2005 and read with section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897. Ergo a specific case may kindly be initiated against them and arranged for its investigation.
