In producing herewith, the 11 (Eleven) persons namely 1. Mantesh Goswami (26) S/O Juren Goswami of Vill-Kanriyor, PO-Rigid, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia 2. Ashutosh Murmu (47) S/O Som @ Samu Murmu of Vill-Telia Bhasa, PO- Ranga, PS-Bagmundi, Dist- Purulia 3. Sushen Tudu (27) S/O Chittu Tudu of Vill- Telia Bhasa, PO- Ranga, PS- Bagmundi, Dist- Purulia 4. Gulup Karmali (28) S/O Bingswar Karmali of Vill + PO- Kalna, PS- Jhalda, Dist- Purulia 5. Buddheswar Mummu (21) S/O Lt. Pada Murmu of Vill- Nawagarh, PO- Bagbinda, PS- Jhalda, Dist- Purulia 6. The fact of the case in a nut shell is that I SI Sujeet Das along with force namely (i) C/386- Sibendra Sinha (ii) C/498- Subal Ch. Mahato (iii) NVF/843- Bibekananda Mahato (iv) HG/1681- Manmutha Kumar were performing the night duty against the night lock down at Jhalda Biesha more under Jhalda PS. Subsequently I along with force arrived at spot at 22:05 hrs. for the implementation of the Govt Order regarding the night restriction. This refers to Jhalda PS GDE No 1198 dttd. 27.07.2021 in consonance with C.C No 2032/21 Dtd. 27.07.2021. During the naka duty at Jhalda Biesha more, I intercepted the above noted 11 (Eleven) persons noted in the super (SI no 1-11), who were loitering aimlessly without wearing the mask and not maintaining the social distance. On being asked they could not give sufficient reason or satisfactory answer of their unwarranted loitering after violating the Government order in this pandemic situation. Consequently, it reasoned to believe that they violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dttd 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dttd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dttd 15/05/2021 and Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dttd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dttd. 14.07.21. Consequently, the supra noted persons were arrested on the spot and informed them the ground of their arrest and issued memo of arrest in respect of them.

As the supra noted persons violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dttd 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dttd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dttd 15/05/2021 and Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dttd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dttd. 14.07.21. Ergo, they can be booked U/S 188 of the IPC and 51 (1) (b) of the Disaster Management Act 2005 and read with section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act. 1897. Ergo a specific case may kindly be initiated against them and arranged for its investigation.
