In producing herewith, the 12 (Twelve) persons namely 1. Narayan Kumar (37) S/O Bhadori Kumar of Vill-Hatkahan, PS-Joypur, Dist-Purulia, 2. Chandi Charan Gorain (32) S/O Mihir Gorain of Ananda bazaar Ward No-01, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 3. Sonu Kandu (26) S/O Naren Kandu of Ananda bazaar Ward No-01, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 4. Mukunda Mahato (38) S/O Ananda Mahato of Vill-Shalgram, PS-Kotshila, Dist-Purulia, 5. Abhiraj Saw (20) S/O Raju Saw of opposite of BL & LRO Jhalda-I office New Baghmundi road, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia, 6. The fact of the case in a nut shell is that I SI. Asoke Kr. Sen along with force namely (i) C/386- Sibendu Sinha (ii) C/1498- Subai Ch. Mahto (iii) HG/1772 Fatik Kumar (iv) HG/1636- Harekrishna Ghosh were performing the raid duty against the night lock down at Jhalda Bus stand under Jhalda PS. Subsequently I along with force arrived at spot at 21:05 hrs. for the implementation of the Govt Order regarding the night restriction. This refers to Jhalda PS GDE No 1371 dtd. 29.07.2021 in consonance with C.C No 2052/21 Dtd. 29.07.2021. During the naka duty at Jhalda Bus stand, I intercepted the above noted 12 (Twelve) persons noted in the supra (SI no 1-12), who were loitering aimlessly without wearing the mask and not maintaining the social distance. On being asked they could not give sufficient reason or satisfactory answer of their unwarranted loitering after violating the Government order in this pandemic situation. Consequently, it reasoned to believe that they violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dtd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 15/05/2021 and Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dtd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd. 14.07.21 and Memo No-753/IV-ISS/2M-22/2021 dtd-29/07/2021. Consequently, the supra noted persons were arrested on the spot and informed them the ground of their arrest and issued memo of arrest in respect of them.

As the supra noted persons violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dtd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 15/05/2021 and Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dtd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd. 14.07.21 and Memo No-753/IV-ISS/2M-22/2021 dtd-29/07/2021. Ergo, they can be booked U/S 188 of the IPC and 51 (1) (b) of the Disaster Management Act 2005 and read with section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897. Ergo a specific case may kindly be initiated against them and arranged for its investigation.
