I, SI Hemanta Kumar Sahababu, S/O- Lt. Madan Mohan Sahababu of Tamna PS, Dist- Purulia, do hereby produce (1) Subhas Paramanik @ Debu (54 Yrs), S/O- Lt. Kaliram Sahis of Vill- Turuhulu, PS-Tamna, Dist-Purulia, (4) Ujjal Bauri (26 Yrs) S/O- Rupchand Bauri of Vill- Bhatbandh (Bauripara), PS-Purulia (T), Dist- Purulia, (5) Goutam Mahato (28 Yrs) S/O- Akul Chandra Mahato of Vill- Ralibera, PS-Tamna, Dist- Purulia and (6) Tapas Mahato (28 yrs) S/O – Sunil Mahato of Vill- Bhatbandh (Mahato Para), PS-Purulia (T), Dist-Purulia and lodge a written complaint against them, to the effect that today on 20.07.2021 while myself along with force of Tamna PS as per direction engaged in Special Mobile duty within Tamna PS area, (Reference Tamna P.S G.D.E No. 863 dated 20.07.2021) for implementation of Government rules of Disaster Management Plan reached at Tamna More under Tamna PS at about 17.05 hrs. and found that the above noted 06(Six) persons were gossiping without wearing mask and not maintaining physical distancing which violates the compliance of norms of wearing of mask and maintaining physical distancing during this pandemic situation in c/w COVID-19. So, there is every reason to believe that the above noted persons were moving without wearing mask and not maintaining physical distancing which violates the compliance of norms of Govt. of India as well as Govt. of West Bengal during this pandemic situation and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases which dangerous to life. So, I have arrested them maintaining all legal formalities as well as notifying the ground of their arrest.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be started against accused produce (1) Subhas Paramanik @ Debu (54 Yrs), S/O- Lt. Akul Paramanik of vill-Bansra, PS- Tamna, Dist-Purulia, (2) Jagrun Sahis (50 Yrs) S/O- Lt. Kaliram Sahis of Vill- Turuhulu, PS-Tamna, Dist-Purulia, (3) Chepu Sahis (51 Yrs) S/O- Lt. Kaliram Sahis of Vill- Turuhulu, PS-Tamna, Dist-Purulia, (4) Ujjal Bauri (26 Yrs) S/O- Rupchand Bauri of Vill- Bhatbandh (Bauripara), PS-Purulia (T), Dist-Purulia, (5) Goutam Mahato (28 Yrs) S/O- Akul Chandra Mahato of Vill- Ralibera, PS-Tamna, Dist-Purulia and (6) Tapas Mahato (28 yrs) S/O – Sunil Mahato of Vill- Bhatbandh (Mahato Para), PS-Purulia (T), Dist-Purulia, under proper section of law as they ignored the norms of Govt. of India as well as Govt. of West Bengal and committed negligent Act. likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and arranged for its investigation.
