Sub: Request for lodging F.I.R. against arrested accused person 1) Dharmendar Singh (26 Yrs) S/O Laxman Singh of Panchudanga, Bahok Para, PS-Adra, Dist- Purulia & 07 Others.

Sir,

In producing herewith Eight (08) arrested accused persons namely (1) Dharmendar Singh (26 Yrs) S/O Laxman Singh of Panchudanga, Bahok Para, PS-Adra, Dist- Purulia (2) Kashinath Malakar (21 Yrs) S/O Khokan Malakar of Panchudanga, Bahok Para, PS-Adra, Dist- Purulia (3) Bablu Singh (30 Yrs) S/O Laxman Singh of Panchudanga, Bahok Para, PS-Adra, Dist- Purulia (4) Raghu Malakar (19 Yrs) S/O Khokan Malakar of Panchudanga, Bahok Para, PS-Adra, Dist- Purulia (5) Bidhan Mahato (26 Yrs) S/O Lt. Ranjit Mahato of Vill- Jiban Pur, PS-Adra, Dist- Purulia (6) Pradip Gorain (26 Yrs) S/O Kartick Gorain of Vill-Kantaranguni, PS-Adra, Dist- Purulia (7) Gorachand Bauri (27 Yrs) S/O Shidam Bauri of Vill- Dalandanga, PS-Adra, Dist- Purulia (8) Paban Bauri (35 Yrs) S/O Saru Bauri of Vill- Dalandanga, PS-Adra, Dist- Purulia with all connected papers.

I beg to state that, today (25.08.2021), I was directed to find out whether the guidelines of Govt regarding not wearing face mask in public in this pandemic situation has been implemented properly at Adra Bazar area or not. Accordingly, I had been to near Joyti More, South Beat Adra along with force vide Adra PS CC NO-3195/21 dtd.25.08.2021 at about 20.25 hrs and found that a gathering appeared near Joyti More, South Beat Adra none of them was wearing face mask. On seeing Police party they have tried to escape from the grip of police party but eight failed to escape due to efficiency effort of police party. On being asked they disclosed their identity as noted above.

They violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media etc for prevention of attack from CORONA Virus/COVID-19. They are creating annoyance to the society & violated govt. order. Though in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India order No- 79-CS/2020 dated 12.04.2020 of the Government of West Bengal, Wearing of facial mask has been mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation. Whereas, vide advisory issued vide no- 715-Home (Cons)/RIM(Cons)-92/2021 dated- 17.04.21, followed by restriction order 753-II-ISS/2M - 22/2020 Dated. 28/06/2021 and 753-III-ISS/2M - 22/2020 Dated. 14/07/2021 of Government of West Bengal has stressed that any violation of mask and social distance norms should be strictly dealt with.

I arrested them for disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued memo of arrest & Inspection Memo. I informed them & their relative regarding the ground of arrest provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). A prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. All the process was done at 20.35 hrs to 21.05 hrs. There was every chance of spread of Infection of disease COVID-19(CORONA VIRUS) which is endanger of human life.

Therefore, I pray a specific case U/S 188/34 IPC and Section 51(1)(b) National Disaster Management Act- 2005 may kindly be lodge against 10 accused persons as noted above. As they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases which is dangerous to lie and arrange for investigation.
