

The humble petition on behalf of above-named Complainant/ petitioner

Most respectfully Sheweth:-

- That the complainant and the accused persons all are permanent residents of village Kalimati within P.S. Baghmundi within district Purulia and within the jurisdiction of this court.
- That the complainant is one of the owner of the land situated at Mouza Kalimati, within P.S Baghmundi, recorded in R.S / L.R Plot. 1445, measuring 42 decimals. The said plot/land has been recorded in his name as well his co-sharers.
- That in the L.R record of right and the said land has been recorded in the names of the complainant and his co-sharers and the complainant and his cosharers are in ownership and possession over the same.
- 4. That in the said plot/land the accused persons namely Pasupati Roy, Kumud Roy, Dilip Roy, and Pranab Roy, all Sons of late Ramkinkar Roy, all are resident of Village and Post Kalimati, P.S Baghmundi, District Purulia have got no right, title, interest and possession.
- 5. That few days ago the complainant came to know that without any title and possession over the said land aforesaid Pasupati Roy and his three brothers in collusion with each other and by practicing fraud mortgaged the said land recorded in R.S./L.R. Plot No. 1445 in favour of one Bhaja Mahato Son of Jhari Mahato, resident of Village Bandhdi, P.O Kalimati, P.S Baghmundi,





District Purulia on 08.06.2021 and illegally have taken Rs.30,000/ (Thirty thousand) from Bhaja Mahato for such mortgage. The said persons also executed a written document to mortgage the land of the complainant. Pashupati Roy and his three brothers had no right to mortgage our property in favour of any person and have no right to collect rent or fees, but the said persons by practicing fraud upon the actual land owners as well as Bhaja Mahato dishonestly mortgage the land of the complainant to grab Rs.30,000/ (Thirty thousand) and in this was they have cheated the original owners of the land as well as Bhaja Mahato.

- 6. That the complainant had been to the Baghmundi P.S. to lodge written complaint before the Officer-in-Charge of Baghmundi P.S., but the Officer-in-Charge of Baghmundi P.S. refused to receive any complaint and as such the complainant sent the said written complaint to the Officer-in-Charge of Baghmundi P.S. by registered post on 05.07.2021 and the same was delivered on 09.07.2021, but the Police did not take any steps in the matter till date.
- 7. That no action was started and/or no specific case was started against the accused persons, the complainant ultimately sent a written complaint to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia by registered post on 13.07.2021, which was delivered on 14.7.2021, but although a reasonable time period has elapsed since there after but no effective step has been taken as yet the complainant has been compelled to take recourse to this learned Court.
- 8. That the accused persons have committed criminal offences for which they are liable to be punished in accordance with law.
- 9. That the complainant is a poor cultivator and he is unable to bear the day to day expenses of a complainant case. The delay towards filling the case has been caused due to the reasons stated in the preceding paragraph and the same may be condoned



It is, therefore, prayed that your honour would graciously be pleased to send this petition of complaint to the Officer-in-charge of Baghmundi Police Station with a direction upon him to investigate the case under section 156 (3) of Cr. P. Code treating the petition of complaint as F.I.R.
