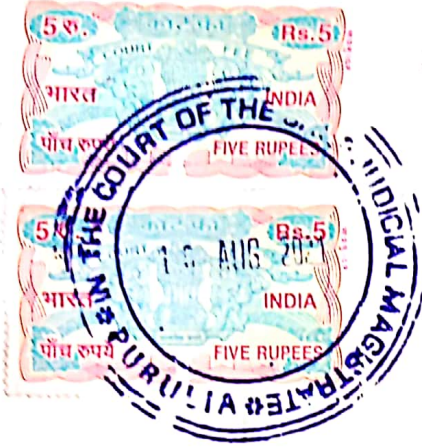

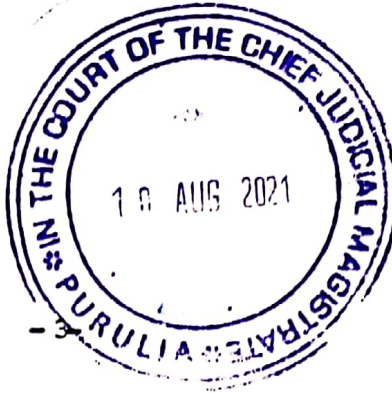

1. The complainant is the permanent resident of village Ranga within p.s. Baghmundih and within the jurisdiction of this court and is an employee of Baghmundih health centre(Asha Karmi).
2. The complainant submits that the accused persons on 6.7.2021 at about 2 P.M. (after noon) rushed to the complainant while complainant was in her house and the accused persons started abusing with filthy language and Adamoni Hembram the accused no. 2 caught the hair of the complainant and started assaulting her after getting the opportunity the accused persons took out the golden ear rings from her ears which amounting to Rs. 19,000/=.
3. The complainant submits that at the time of assaulting the complainant and the other persons of the village were present but sudden attack to the complainant they became surprise and could not resist the accused persons. from assaulting the complainant.
4. That after the incident the complainant along with her husband raised to the local p.s. to lodge a complaint against the accused persons but the police did not take any steps against the accused persons.
5. That the complainant thereafter submit a complain before the S.P. Purulia.
