- 3) That at the time of marriage the father of your petitioner paid Rs. Two Lakhs in cash to the accused person 1, 2 and 3 as per their dowry demand alongwith furnitures amounting Rs. Seventy five thousands and sufficient amount of Gold ornaments and silver ornaments to meet their demand.
- 4) That after marriage your petitioner started living with her husband peacefully with dreams in eyes.
- 5) That after about six months, your petitioner noticed various changes in the character of all the accused persons, kindness, love, affection from everybody was vanished and cruelty & greed replaced of the good sides of the persons.

- 6) That all the accused persons with a joint hands, including her husband started physical and mental tortures upon your petitioner. The accused persons, 1, 2, and 3 started giving hard pressure upon your petitioner to bring more money from her father to purchase Motor cycle and to aid some money in their agriculture expenditure.
- 7) That the poor father of your petitioner, after hearing from her daughter started paying the accused persons small amounts of installment anticipating peace in the life of his daughter.
- 8) That the greed and demand for money had been increasing day to day and one time payments was stopped due to financial hardsheep of the father of your petitioner.
- 9) That as a result of not supplying money by the poor father of the complainant, unspeakable torture both physical and mental began to commit upon your complainant by all the accused persons.
- 10) That the accused persons used to keep your petitioner without proper food, proper dress and with utter negligence.
- 11) That all the ornaments, and good quality costly dresses etc. were snached from her by the accused person.

- 12) That the complainant was not allowed to even become the bed-partner of her husband to keep her under pressure.
- 13) That your petitioner, finding no way and also hoping that in some near future everything will be perfect and peaceful but in vain.
- 14) That all the accused persons used to beat your petitioner mercilessly as an object to torture any time.
- 15) That the accused husband along with ~~the~~ other directed the complainant to leave the house and to start living with her father as they made plan to arrange re-marriage for the accused husband. Whenever they demanded him to leave the house she used to deny and became the subject of torture.
- 16) That all of a sudden on 02/07/2020 before Rakhi Purnima previous year, the accused husband took your complainant to her father at Khatjuri village and at once left ~~the~~ his father-in-laws resident without caring the request to stay a while by the father-in-law and others.
- 17) That since that day, the accused husband and others did not maintain any communication any connection by any means with your petitioner.
- 18) That your petitioner and her father, mother other well-wishers tried a lot to set the complainant again with her husband, but the accused persons did not pay any heed to their request to move settlement with the complainant by any condition.

- 22) That all the accused persons with a common intension with joined hands have committed offence by torturing your petitioner, punishable under various sections of law.

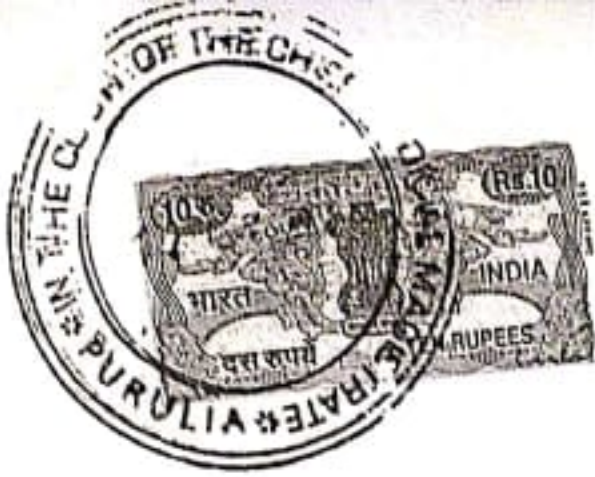
