In producing herewith, the 05 (Five) persons namely 1. Rajesh Mahato (27) S/O Chittaranjan Mahato of Vill- Bandhdih, PO-Mosina, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia 2. Md. Ahsan Sheikh (34) S/O Md. Nausad Sheikh of Vill- Jangal Para, PS-Radhanagar, Dist- Sahebganj (JKD) 3. Dharmendra Mahato (24) S/O Shambhunath Mahato of Vill- Jaruadih, PO-Jargo, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia 4. Rakesh Mahato (22) S/O Gokul Mahato of Vill- Jaruadih, PO-Jargo, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia 5. Danu Singh Mura (25) S/O Jeet Singh Mura of Vill- Mandi, PS-Kotshila, Dist-Purulia.

The fact of the case in a nut shell is that I SI Asoke Kr. Sen along with force namely (i) C/682 Mahadeb Rajak (ii) C/696 Gorapada Pal (iii) HG/1636 Harekrishna Ghosh (iv) NVF/778 Samir Mahato were performing the raid duty against the night lock down at Bus-stand under Jhalda PS. Subsequently I along with force arrived at spot on 17.08.2021 at 23:05 hrs. for the implementation of the Govt Order regarding the night restriction. This refers to Jhalda PS GDE No 786 dtd. 17.08.2021 in consonance with C.C No 3180/21 Dtd. 17.08.2021. During the naka duty at Bus-stand, I intercepted the above noted 05 (Five) persons noted in the supra (Sl. No 1-5) , who were loitering aimlessly without wearing the mask and not maintaining the social distance. On being asked they could not give sufficient reason or satisfactory answer of their unwarranted loitering after violating the Government order in this pandemic situation. Consequently, it reasoned to believe that they violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dtd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 15/05/2021 and Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dtd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd. 14.07.21 and Memo No-753/IV-ISS/2M-22/2021 dtd-29/07/2021. Thereafter in addition to the order of Govt. Of West Bengal for all outdoor activities from 23:00 hrs to 05:00 hrs vide order No- -753/V-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated-13/08/2021. Consequently, the supra noted persons were arrested on the spot and informed them the ground of their arrest and issued memo of arrest in respect of them.

As the supra noted persons violated the order and disobeyed the direction during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 753-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 14/06/2021 in consonance with order promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No 486-CS/2021 dtd 24/04/2021 following with the order of Govt. of West Bengal vide Memo No-647-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd 15/05/2021 and Memo No 753/II-ISS/2M-22/20 dtd. 28.06.21 and Memo No 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020 dtd. 14.07.21 and Memo No-753/IV-ISS/2M-22/2021 dtd-29/07/2021. Thereafter in addition to the order of Govt. Of West Bengal for all outdoor activities from 23:00 hrs to 05:00 hrs vide order No- -753/V-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated-13/08/2021. Ergo, they can be booked U/S 188 of the IPC and 51 (b) of the Disaster Management Act 2005 and read with section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act. 1897. Ergo a specific case may kindly be initiated against them and arranged for its investigation.

Received on 17.8.21 at 23.45 hrs. and started Jhalda PS Case No 130/21 dtd 17/8/21 U/S 188 of the IPC and 51 (b) of the Disaster Management Act 2005 and read with Section 3 of Epidemic Diseases Act 1897 and endorsed to ASI Samir Kr. Mishra for its investigation.
