In producing herewith 06 (Six) arrested accused persons 1) Balaram Mahato (23 Y) S/O-Tarani Mahato of Vill-Palashbani, PS- Arsha 2) Gokul Paramanik (30 Y) S/O- Jagan Paramanik of Vill-Barametyala, PS- Kotshila 3) Soukat Ray (18 Y) S/O- Atul Ch. Ray of Vill- Gowaladih, P.S- Kotshila 4) Mahadeb Mahato (34 Y) S/O-Lt. Ashari Mahato of Vill- Pratappur, PS- Joypur 5) Parikhit Kumar (41 Y) S/O-Abhimunna Kumar of Vill-Oldih, PS- Kotshila 6) Prabin Mahato (23 Y) S/O- Madhab Mahato of vill- Chitorpur, PS- Kotshila all of Dist- Purulia.

I beg to state that today (01.08.2021), I SI Debabrata Chakraborty with C/982 Shyamal Rajwar & C/601 Shyamlal Mandi was directed to find out whether wearing of mask by the public has been properly maintained at Kotshila Hattola More or not. Accordingly, I had been to Kotshila Hattola More at about 15:00 hrs found that a gathering appeared at Kotshila Hattola More, none of them were wearing mask. On seeing Police they have tried to escape from the grip of police party but some failed to escape due to efficient effort of Police. On being asked they disclosed their identity as noted above & they were loiterer there without any purpose.

In this pandemic situation of CORONA Virus/COVID-19 the above noted persons violated the order duly promulgated by government and order vide memo no. 715-Home(Com)/RIM/(Com)-92/21 dated. 17.04.2021 of Govt. of West Bengal regarding any violation of masks and social distance norms should be strictly dealt with and memo no. 486-CS/2021 dated 24.04.2021 of Govt. of West Bengal & Order no- 753-ISS/2M-22/2020, Dt- 14/06/2021 & Order no- 753/II-ISS/2M-22/2020, Dt- 28/06/2021 & Order no- 753/III-ISS/2M-22/2020, Dt- 14/07/2021 & Order no-753/IV-ISS/2M-22/2020, Dt- 29/07/2021. So, I arrested them for disobedience of order duly promulgated by public servant. After maintaining all rules of arrest, issued memo of arrest. I informed them & their relatives regarding the ground of arrest i.e. as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). At prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. All the process was done in between 15:05 hrs to 15:30 hrs. There was every chance of breach of peace and requiring of offence if not arrested.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be lodge against above noted accused persons as they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to lie and violated the rule U/S 188/34 IPC and Section 51(1) (b) National Disaster Management Act- 2005 and arrange for investigation.
