The Complainant above named begs to state as follows:

1. That the Complainant is a tenant under one Srimatya Sadhana Sarkar in respect of one Shop-Room and one Godown within Holding no. 238 and Ward no. 13. The monthly rent of the Shop-Room is Rs. 3200.00 and of the Godown is Rs. 1200.00.

2. That the Complainant deals in Tyre Business and various costly articles kept both in the Godown and the Shop-Room.
3. That as Sadhana Sarkar (since deceased) tried to evict the Complainant forcibly which compelled the Complainant to file a Title Suit being no. 88/2019 in the Court of the Ld. Civil Judge (Junior Division), Raghunathpur, praying for Declaration of his Tenancy Right and Permanent Injunction. The Complainant also filed Petition for Injunction restraining the aforesaid Sadhana Sarkar from evicting/ejecting him from the Tenanted Shop-Room and Godown and/or otherwise interfering with the possession of the Complainant.
4. That the Ld. Court after hearing has been pleased to allow the said prayer of Ad-Interim Injunction and directed to maintain Status-Quo with regard to nature, character and possession. The Order of the Ld. Court was duly communicated and Sadhana Sarkar appeared in that Suit through her Ld. Lawyer.
5. That on 08/11/2020 the said Sadhana Sarkar whimsically closed the passage of the Godown by constructing Pucca Wall and on 18/11/2020 the said Sadhana Sarkar started construction of Corrugated/Tin Shed made with Iron Pipes in front of the Tenanted Shop.
6. That the Complainant filed Petition for Local Inspection and his prayer was allowed and the Ld. Commissioner submitted Report.
7. That the aforesaid Sadhana Sarkar expired on 02/07/2021 and due to her death Accused nos. 1 and 2 who are the daughter and son-in-law of Sadhana Sarkar came to Raghunathpur. It may be mentioned here that Accused nos. 1 and 2 and the other daughter of Sadhana Sarkar namely Ranjana Roy were/are aware about the solemn order of the Ld. Court. Accused no. 1 is the eldest daughter of the deceased Sadhana Sarkar and both Accused nos. 1 and 2 resides at 2/11, Nrisingha Dutta Road, Sakher Bazar, Barisha, Kolkata.
8. That on 07/07/2021 at about 09.30-10.00 AM both the Accused nos. 1 and 2 along with some unknown persons came near the Godown and broken the Padlock kept by the Complainant and they opened the Wooden Door and removed the costly Articles such as Tyres, Tubes, Tyres Fittings etc. The said Accused persons and their associates scattered/thrown some Articles in front of the Godown and they purposely removed some Articles in their Rooms. It may be mentioned here that the Residential House of Sadhana Sarkar is on the First Floor and the Godown is situated on the Ground Floor.
9. That the Accused persons when throwing and removing the Articles the Complainant and his Witnesses protested but Accused no. 1 threatened that she with the help of her associates will kill them and further threatened that she will lodge false Case as she is a Lady. The associates of Accused nos. 1 and 2 were masked and accordingly the Complainant and his Witnesses could not recognize them.
10. That the Accused persons by forming an unlawful assembly with an intention to commit loss of the Complainant's Property criminally trespassed into the Godown and damaged the Articles and also thrown some of the Articles in front of the Godown and removed some Articles to obtain unlawful gain.
11. That the Complainant sustained a loss of Rs. 100000.00 and above due to overt acts and stealing of Tyres, Tubes and other Articles and the amount of the Articles which were thrown by the Accused will be of Rs. 400000.00.

- 12. That the Accused persons by abusing the Complainant and his brothers with gutter and vulgar languages left the place after giving threatening that they will also damage the Shop-Room of the Complainant.
- 13. That the Complainant had been to local Thana for lodging Complaint but the Police declined to receive a Diary as a Civil Suit is pending.
- 14. That the Complainant thereafter sent Notices before Inspector in Charge, Raghunathpur, and also to S.D.P.O, Raghunathpur and S.P, Purulia by Registered Post with Acknowledge Dues.
- 15. That Raghunathpur Police In-spite of loss sustained by the Complainant did not taken any action against the culprits and ultimately the Accused nos. 1 and 2 left Raghunathpur.
- 16. That Witness nos. 2 and 3 are the brothers of the Complainant and Witness no. 4 is a staff of the Complainant and they witnessed the occurrence.
- 17. That search and seizure is involved and the Complainant sustained huge loss of Tyres, Tubes and other Articles due to commission of offence made by the Accused persons.
- 18. That the Accused persons has committed an offence under Sections 379, 427, 447 and 34 of Indian Penal Code.
- 19. That due to the overt acts the Complainant sustained huge loss and became mentally ill and he is not in a position to proceed with the Case in his personal capacity.
- 20. That the Complainant took some snaps of the commission of offence committed by the Accused persons.
- 21. That the Complainant invokes the provision under Section 156(3) of C.R.P.C.

It is therefore prayed that your Honour would be pleased to direct the Inspector-In-Charge, Raghunathpur P.S, to start a Case under Sections 379, 427, 447 and 34 of Indian Penal Code against the Accused persons by treating this Petition of Complaint as F.I.R as provided under Section 156(3) of C.R.P.C.
