(Reference Tamna P.S G.D.E No. 603 dtd 13.08.2021) for implementation of Government rules of Disaster Management Plan reached at Chakaltore Bazar under Tamna PS at about 21:25 hrs. and found that the above noted 05 (Five) persons were gossiping without wearing mask and not maintaining physical distancing which violates the compliance of norms of wearing of mask and maintaining physical distancing during this pandemic situation in c/w COVID-19. So, there is every reason to believe that the above noted persons were moving without wearing mask and not maintaining physical distancing which violates the compliance of norms of Govt. of India as well as Govt of West Bengal during this pandemic situation and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases which dangerous to life. So, I have arrested them maintaining all legal formalities as well as notifying the ground of their arrest.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be started against accused produce (1) Pranab Mahato (22 Yrs), S/O- Birinchi Mahato of Vill- Manara, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia. (2) Paresh Rajwar (27 Yrs), S/O- Lt. Budhu Rajwar of Vill- Doldari, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia. (3) Tapas Mahato (21 Yrs) S/O- Ajoy Mahato of Vill- Bungera, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia.
