Chhutu Mahato of Vill- Manikdih, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia and lodge a written complaint against them, to the effect that today on 14.08.2021 while myself along with force of Tamna PS as per direction engaged in Anti Crime PS Mobile duty within Tamna PS area, (Reference Tamna P.S G.D.E No. 628 dtd. 14.08.2021) for implementation of Government rules of Disaster Management Plan reached at Chengi More under Tamna PS at about 21:05 hrs. and found that the above noted 06 (Six) persons were gossiping without wearing mask and not maintaining physical distancing which violates the compliance of norms of wearing of mask and maintaining physical distancing during this pandemic situation in c/w COVID-19. So, there is every reason to believe that the above noted persons were moving without wearing mask and not maintaining physical distancing which violates the compliance of norms of Govt. of India as well as Govt. of West Bengal during this pandemic situation and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases which dangerous to life. So, I have arrested them maintaining all legal formalities as well as notifying the ground of their arrest.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be started against accused produce (1) Saddam Ansary (24 Yrs), S/O- Golam Ansary of Vill- Misirdi, PS- Arsha, Dist- Purulia, (2) Bharat Lohar (20 Yrs), S/O- Gopal Lohar of Vill- Bukadih, PS- Bagmundi, Dist- Purulia, (3) Gurupada Singh Sardar (20 Yrs) S/O- Lt. Ajit Singh Sardar of Vill- Khuntard, PS- Balarampur, Dist- Purulia, (4) Santi Ram Mahato (35 Yrs), S/O- Laxmi Kanta Mahato of Vill- Belguma Sati Mandir, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia, (5) Raub Khan (23 Yrs) S/O- Sakir Khan of Vill - Pachukuda, PS- Barabazar, Dist- Purulia, (6) Tapan Mahato (21 Yrs) S/O- Lt.
