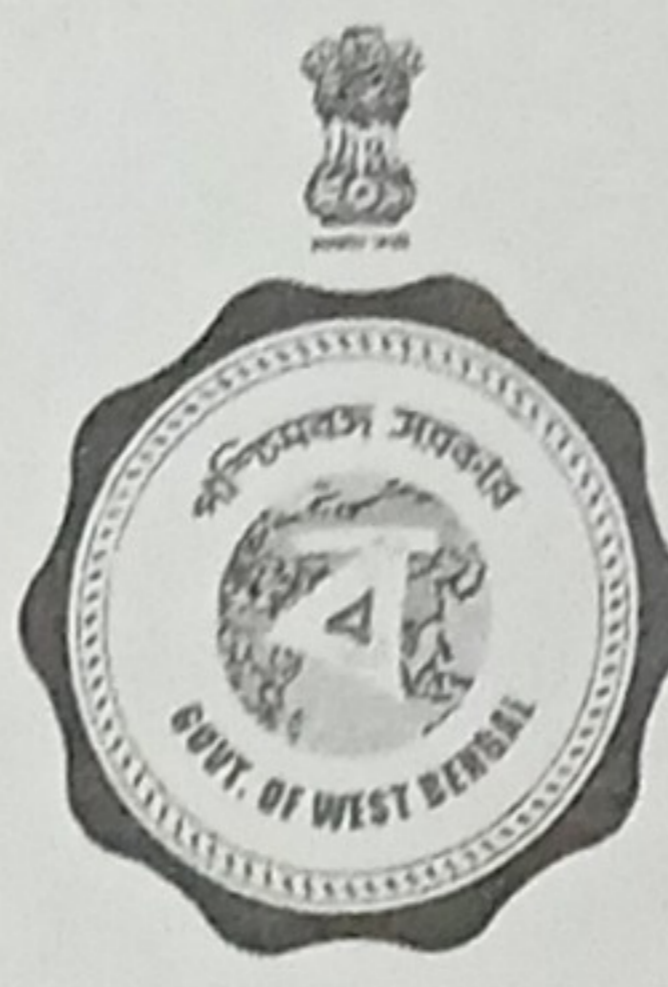

Sub: - Complaint against offence u/s 21(1) of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957; Rule 3 of the WB Minerals (Prevention of illegal Mining, Transportation and Storage) Rules, 2002; Rule 50 of the West Bengal Minor Minerals Concession Rule 2016.

One vehicle (Tractor) bearing Registration No **WB 55 B 1052** carrying 100 (one hundred) cft(approx) of Quartz in separate trolley has been intercepted by the undersigned on 27/09/2021 at around 17.00 hrs at Burigora to Gangamanna road. The driver of the said vehicle failed to produce any lawful authority or valid transit pass to carry such mineral and while talking he fled away. Thus the Driver/Owner of the vehicle has violated the provisions of Section 4(1)/4(1A) of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, and liable to be prosecuted with imprisonment for a term which may be extended up to 2(two) years or Rs. One lakh fine or both, in accordance with Sec.21(1) of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, Rule 3 of the WB Minerals (Prevention of illegal Mining, Transportation and Storage) Rules, 2002, Rule 50 of the WB Minor Minerals Concession Rule 2016 and also u/s 379/411 of the Indian Penal Code.

The said seized vehicle along with 100 cft of Quartz in separate trolley has been brought to PS and handed over your custody on today i.e. 28/09/2021

Therefore, you are requested to initiate a specific case against the offender in terms of law. This should be treated as FIR.
