Sir,

I, SI Milon Manna along with ASI Sk Abdul Jamshed & force return to PS and brought under seizure 02 (two) seized Tractors- (i) One tractor having Registration No WB55A-1930 (ii) Another tractor without any Number plate having tempered Engine No and Chassis No both are attached with sand loaded trolleys (each approx 100 cft). The fact in brief is that today (11.09.2021) I along with ASI Sk Abdul Jamshed & force namely i) C/958 Madhusudan Ojha ii) C/1496 Subal Ch. Mahato iii) HG/1636 Harekrishna Ghosh were performing M.V. checking & raid duty in PS area vide Jhalda P.S. GDE No- 1063 Dated- 11/09/2021 in consonance with Jhalda PS CC No- 3534/21 Dated- 11/09/2021. During my M.V. checking & raid duty I received credible source information that two Tractors was lifting & carrying sand illegally and coming from Sarjumatu Ghat which is situated on Subarnarekha River at Jharkhand Purulia Border & coming towards Jhalda Town. Subsequently, I informed you and as per your gracious order, I placed Naka at Sarjumatu More to work out this tip off and started Naka Checking after proper placing guard rail on the road. Thereafter I saw the two tractors were proceeding towards Sarjumatu More. Consequently, we intercepted the said Tractors at before Naka checking point at about 10:45 hrs and found that the vehicle as well as goods as identical as I received prior information. But seeing the Police Party driver of Tractors fled away leaving the Tractors on road before Naka checking point. We tried to apprehend them but failed. We waited for reasonable time but none came to spot. It was ascertained that the driver of the tractors loaded the said sand in cahoots with the owner of the vehicles by illegal means for selling the same to make profit by dishonestly and they had been running a clandestine business. So it is reasoned to belief that they in cahoots with the owners of the vehicle procured the said sand from Subarnarekha River from Sarjumatu Ghat by fraudulently means or theft by any means for transporting the same to run clandestine business. Ergo I, seized the vehicle (i) One tractor having Registration No WB55A-1930 (ii) Another tractor without any Number plate having tempered Engine No and Chassis No both are attached with sand loaded trolleys (each approx 100 cft) under proper seizure list in presence of available witnesses duly signed by them. Thereafter, I brought the said tractor to Jhalda PS compound.

Under the above facts and circumstances kindly take lawful action against the Owner & driver of the said vehicle as they committed offence U/S 379/411/414/120B of the IPC & 21 (1)(4) Mines and Minerals (R&D) Act-1957
