Sub: Complaint against offence u/s 21(1) of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 ; Rule 3 of the WB Minerals (Prevention of illegal Mining, Transportation and Storage) Rules, 2002; Rule 50 of the West Bengal Minor Minerals Concession Rule 2016.

One vehicle bearing Registration No. WB 55A8349 and two other vehicles bearing no registration number carrying 100 cft (Approximately) of sand in each vehicle in separate trolley has been intercepted by the undersigned on 24.09.2021 between 6.30am and 7.00am hrs. at Kantabera, Sindri, near Chas More, Purulia. The driver of the said vehicles failed to produce any authorized transit pass to carry such mineral and while talking they fled away. Thus the Driver/Owner of the vehicles have violated and provisions of Section 4(1)/4(1A) of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, and liable to be prosecuted with imprisonment for a term which may extend upto 2 yrs or Rs One lakh fine or both , in accordance with section 21(1) of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) act, 1957, Rule 3 of the WB Minerals (Prevention of illegal Mining Transportation and Storage) Rules, 2002; Rule 50 of the WB Minor Minerals Concession Rule 2016 and also under Section 379/411 of the Indian Penal Code.

The said seized three vehicles along with 100 Cft. Of sand in each separate trolley have been brought to PS and handed over to your custody.

Therefore, you are requested to initiate a specific case against the offender in terms of law. This should be treated as FIR.
