Sir,

I, LSI Elora Rakshit of Purulia (T) PS do hereby lodged complaint against (1) Subrata Choudhury, Secretary, DYFI, Purulia Town South Area Committee, (2) Sushanta Mahato, member of DYFI, Purulia Town Committee Purulia, (3) Arka Halder, member of DYFI, (4) Bijoy Sen, member of DYFI, (5) Bhaktaranjan Mahato, SFI, District Secretary Purulia and 15/20 unknown others, all are members of DYFI, Purulia Town South Area Committee. Today (22.10.2021) in between 16:00 to 16:30 hrs, I have received a source information that the above noted persons are organized a protest from Purulia Zilla School More to Bhagat Singh More under Purulia (T) PS with party flag, "Mashal" and banners in protest against recent attacks on Hindu Temple in Bangladesh without any information of permission.

As the pandemic period related to COVID-19 is going on and hence to prevent its mass spreading the Central Govt. & the State Govt. has passed an order to wear mask in the public place is mandatory and ordered to prosecute the defaulters. They violated the order duly promulgated by the government through public servants and through media etc for prevention of spreading of CORONA Virus/COVID-19. They were creating annoyance to the society & violated the govt. order. Though in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India order No- 79-CS/2020 dated 12.04.2020 and order No- 753/X-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated 30.09.2021 of the Government of West Bengal, Wearing of facial mask has been mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation. Whereas, vide advisory issued vide no- 715-Home (Cons)/RIM(Cons)-92/2021 dated- 17.04.21, Government of West Bengal has stressed that any violation of mask and social distance norms should be strictly dealt with.

Hence I pray before you to start a specific case against the above noted persons under proper section of law.

As such they have violated section 188/34 IPC & 32 Police Act Section, 51(b) in the Disaster Management Act, 2005.


So I request you for starting a case and also for arranging its investigation.
