(5) Bapi Mahato (22 Yrs) S/O- Dulal Mahato of Vill- Hirakhap, P.O- Pichasi, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia, and lodge a written complaint against them, to the effect that today on 26.10.2021 while myself along with force of Tamna PS as per direction enged in PS Evening/Night Mobile duty within Tamna PS area. (Reference Tamna P.S G.D.E No. 1101 dtd. 26.10.2021) for implementation of Government rules of Disaster Management Plan reached at Chengi More under Tamna PS at about 23:05 hrs. and found that the above noted 05(Five) persons were gossiping without wearing mask and not maintaining physical distancing which violates the compliance of norms of wearing of mask and maintaining physical distancing during this pandemic situation in c/w COVID-19. So, there is every reason to believe that the above noted persons were moving without wearing mask and not maintaining physical distancing which violates the compliance of norms of Govt. of India as well as Govt. of West Bengal during this pandemic situation and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases which dangerous to life. So, I have arrested them maintaining all legal formalities as well as notifying the ground of their arrest.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be started against accused (1) Bhim Bauri (45 Yrs), S/O- Lt. Madan Bauri of Vill- Damda, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia. (2) Sukhen Bauri (22 Yrs), S/O- Prabash Bauri of Vill- Damda, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia. (3) Iwar Kumar (21 Yrs) S/O- Lakhan Kumar of Vill- Uparbatri, PS- Kotshila, Dist- Purulia. (4) Dhananjoy Mahato (20 Yrs), S/O- Barani Mahato of Vill- Nimdiha, PS- Hura, Dist- Purulia. (5) Bapi Mahato (22 Yrs) S/O- Dulal Mahato of Vill- Hirakhap, P.O- Pichasi, PS- Tamna, Dist- Purulia, under proper section of law as they ignored the norms of Govt. of India as well as Govt. of West Bengal and committed negligent Act, likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and arranged for its investigation.
