Today (26.11.2021) myself SI Parimal Ghosh along with force were engaged in mobile duty vide C.C NO- 3630/2021, GDE No- 1181 dt-26.11.2021 and as per direction we were engaged for implementation of Govt. rules regarding violation of wearing of mask. on 26.11.2021 At about 23.05 Hrs, myself along with force already been setup a Naka Checking post at Chhotourma Hattala under Balarampur P.S, Dist.-Purulia. During Naka checking we found that the 05/06 persons moving aimlessly without wear mask on seen the Police party they are fled away somehow we managed 03 (three) persons namely 1) Biswajit Das (19 yrs) S/O- Sadhu Charan Das of Vill- Chhotourma, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.-Purulia, 2) Brihaspati Mahato (23 yrs) S/O- Saktipada Mahato of Vill- Chhotourma, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.-Purulia, 3) Rupesh Mahato (24 yrs) S/O- Bholanath Mahato of Barourma, P.S- Balarampur, Dist.-Purulia were moving aimlessly. Despite of having the importance of wearing mask none of them put it on. Rather they started giving excuses for not wearing the same and tried to pass through our Police party. It is to mention worthy that rapid awareness programme through canvassing had been done since last month by the Balarampur Police Station but these people did not take care of that. Hence, there is every reason to believe that the aforesaid person came out from their home without any reason which may result in spreading of infection. As such the above persons violated the order during this pandemic situation duly promulgated by Govt. of West Bengal vide up dated order No 753/X - ISS/2M -22/2020 Dated. 30/09/2021 and subsequently Order No- 753/IX-ISS/2M-22/2020 Date- 15.09.2021. Therefore they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life. Hence I arrested them after maintaining all arrest formalities regarding arrest guided by NHRC and Apex Court of India.

Under the above circumstances, I pray that a cognizable case may kindly be started against above noted 03 (three) persons.
