law relating to successors has already been changed in the year 1956 and also later on. From the documents filed by both the parties it appears that various litigations are pending between the parties and question of right of sole 'Sebait' is also a question of issue in various suits.

In the matter of return of seized deities, Shalagram Shilas and other seized properties and family deity i.e. 'Sri Sri Shyam Raghubar Jew' at 'Thakurbari' at Kashipur which is at present lying in the Thana premises is the burning question which is required to be re-installed for Nityapuja, Bhogdan, Arati, traditional ceremonies, etc. for the interest of 'Rajparibar' and also for the public at large.

In the above circumstances, this court already heard a neutral person of that area as per report submitted by the O.C., Kashipur P.S. that one Goutam Chakraborty, son of Madhusudan Chakraborty of village and P.O. Ramchandrapur, P.S. Santuri, district Purulia who is also present before this court and agreed to do the work of re-installation of 'Sri Sri Shyam Raghubar Jew', Shalagram Shilas and other deities and to report before this court monthly that daily Nityapuja, Bhogdan, Arati, traditional ceremonies, etc. are being performed regularly as per rites and custom of 'Rajparibar'.

O.C., Kashipur P.S. is directed to give interim custody of 'Sri Sri Shyam Raghubar Jew', Shalagram Shilas, deities and other materials as per seizure list to the priest of the Thakurbari viz. Tapan Acharjya in presence of both the parties and in presence of learned Advocates.

that Maharaja Jyoti Prasad Singh Deo was the owner of the estate known as 'Panchakotraj' and earned revenue thereon, holder of Touzi No.19 of the-then district Manbhumi under the State of Bihar and his ancestors had established the family deity 'Sri Sri Shyam Raghubar Jew' at 'Thakurbari' of Kashipur. The deity 'Sri Sri Shyam Raghubar Jew' was the actual owner of 'Debottar Mahal' of the district Manbhumi and the said Maharaja Jyoti Prasad Singh Deo dedicated some other mouzas in favour of deities for exclusive religious purpose. After the death of Maharaja Jyoti Prasad Singh Deo his three sons viz. Raja Kalyani Prasad Singh Deo, Rajkishore Singh Deo and Ajit Prasad Singh Deo of which Singh Deo Rajkishore died unmarried and after death of Raja Kalyani Prasad Singh Deo in the year 1945 , his successors are Shankari Prasad Singh Deo, Jagadeswari Prasad Singh Deo and Jayanti Prasad Singh Deo. One of the petitioners in this case is Jagadananda Prasad Singh Deo is the son of Ajit Prasad Singh Deo. The religious ceremonies of various deities are used to be maintained by the descendants of Maharaja Jyoti Prasad Singh Deo and the second petitioner, Maheswari Devi is the daughter of Shankari Prasad Singh Deo. Raja Shankari Prasad Singh Deo died in the year 1956 leaving behind Raja Bhubaneswari Singh Deo, and Rani Maheswari Devi(minor). As such, their natural guardian, Rajmata Durgesh Kumari Devi became the sole authority of Panchakotraj personal estate and Debottar Estate. In the year 1972 Bhubaneswari Singh Deo expired (bachelor). Rajmata Durgesh Kumari Devi expired leaving behind her only daughter, Maheswari Devi in the year 1990. As such,

Ramchandrapur, P.S. Santuri, district Purulia who has full knowledge regarding daily Nityapuja, Bhogdan, Arati, etc. and rites and custom of the historical 'Rajbari'.

Heard learned Prosecution. In the circumstances, issue notice upon Sri Goutam Chakraborty, son of Madhusudan Chakraborty of village and P.O. Ramchandrapur P.S. Santuri, district Purulia to appear before this court on 5.3.2010 at 10-30 A.M. sharp.

5-03-10 Learned Advocates for both sides are also present. Heard the learned Advocates of both the sides and the learned prosecution. Perused the documents filed by both the parties along with Firisti.

It appears from the F.I.R. that one Tapan Acharjya, son of late Dwijapada Acharjya aged about 35 years by occupation priest of village Pathpur, P.S.Kashipur, district Purulia lodged the written complaint before the O.C., Kashipur P.S. on 28.1.2010 to the effect that at about 8.30 P.M. some unknown miscreants committed theft at 'Thakurbari' of "Sri Sri Shyam Raghubar Jew" of Kashipur under P.S.Kashipur in respect of ancient idols, Shalagram Shila, deities and Puja articles which were also mentioned in the F.I.R. It appears from the petitions for return by both the parties viz. Jagadananda Prasad Singh Deo and also from one Hakeswari Devi of 'Rajparioar' and chronological descendants which are admitted by both the parties

of both the sides and also in presence of Goutam Chakraborty
within one month from the date of this order and cause
report to be submitted before this court that re-installation
of idol 'Sri Sri Shyam Raghubar Jew', Shalagram Shilas,
deities and other materials and daily Nityapuja, Bhogdan,
Arati, traditional ceremonies, etc. be continued peacefully.
Sri Goutam Chakraborty, son of Madhusudan Chakraborty
of village Ramchandrapur, P.S. Santuri, district Purulia
who is appointed for the purpose is directed to issue notice
upon both the parties and to fix up one suitable date for
its re-installation and daily Nityapuja, Bhogdan, Arati,
'Sankalpa' in the name of both the petitioners and also legal
heirs of 'Rajparibar' traditional ceremonies, etc. as per rites and custom
of the 'Rajparibar'. The family deity viz. 'Sri Sri
Shyam Raghubar Jew' shall be maintained by both the
petitioners and also by the legal heirs of 'Rajparibar'
and send a report month by month before this court
that daily Nityapuja, Bhogdan, Arati, etc. are going
on peacefully and to secure the presence of both the
petitioners and other legal heirs of 'Rajparibar'.

O.C., Kashipur P.S. is also directed to ensure the safety and security of the seized articles of this case.

The petitions are thus disposed.

Final order in respect of the prayer for return
of seized deities will be considered at the time of trial.

Inform all concerned accordingly at once.

Sir,

I, Sri Biswajit Prasad Singh Deo, S/o. Late Jagad-manda Prasad Singh Deo, of Ajit Behawan (Bans Bagley) Ranchi Road, Purulia, beg to inform you that after the death of my father, I am the Sebait of Sri Sri Shyam Rayluban Jee & looking after the Seva Puja of the deity.

On 15.11.2021 at about 2.20 A.M., I received a call from Sri Ramanuj Deogharia, manager & incharge of Thakur bari at Kashipur informing me that a theft has been committed in the temple and few antique idols and few other items have been stolen by the miscreants.

Today at around 11.00 AM. we came to the temple premises and took stock of the items stolen i.e. one idol of Krishna & one idol of Radha alongwith Silver items, like chain, Mukut & flute, two metal idols of Krishna (Bal Gopal) about 6 inches height, two small white Shaligram Silas & few brass & copper utensils used during puja & also we came to know that the mobile (Make: Samsung Guru, no. 9679914999) and some cash which was kept in a box (Rs. 2600/-) was forcibly taken away.

Further, I would like to inform you that previously on 28.01.2016 a similar incident took place and a copy of the A.C.J.M. Raghunathpur court is enclosed herewith bearing G.R. no. 41/10 for your perusal. Under the above circumstances I would like to request to investigate the matter and recover the stolen articles as early as possible.
