Sub: Complaint against extraction, stock of stone in Ambari mouza


In reference with the above mentioned subject matter this is to inform you that some unknown person(s) extracting and making stock of stone illegally in Ambari Mouza . It is also informed by Sri Mansaram Tudu of village Ambari that phelsper/quartz are crushed through some crusher units in Ambari Mouza. The raid team of the Office of the BL&LRO, Santuri with police personnel has exercised the order conferred upon by Sub Section of Section 211 of the Minor & Minerals (R&S) Act, 1957 vide Order No 08-01/SR,D dated 24/01/91 of the Commerce and Industries Department of the Govt. of West Bengal. But at the time of raid a black stone mine, a water pump and a crusher machine found but neither any vehicle nor any person was found during raid. Approx 100 cft black stone found scattered around the mine.No quartz mine was found at time of raid.

So, I am lodging a complaint to your end for taking necessary legal action.
