The humble petition of the petitioner Most Respectfully,

SHEWETH:-

- 1. That Vivekananda Vikash Kendra is a registered society having Registration No. SO063681 of 1989-1990 under The West Bengal Societies Registration Act, 1961, having its registered office at Dhundikhap, Post Davatorang, Police Station Bagmundi, District Purulia, West Bengal 723152.
- 2. That the Complainant is the Secretary of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra and a social worker, peace loving and law-abiding citizen of India having full faith on the law.
- 3. That the Accused Person No. (1) is the Executive Committee member of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra and the Accused Person No. (2) is the general member of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra.
- 4. That the Accused Person Nos. (3) to (9) are outsiders having no relation with the Executive Committee of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra thus having no business with the workings of Executive Committee of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra.
- 5. That the Accused Person Nos. (1) and (2) have a good relationship with the local hoodlums.





- 6. That the Accused Person Nos. (1) to (9) are quarrelsome by their nature and have no respect for the law.
- 7. Your Petitioner states that the Society namely Vivekananda Vikash Kendra, having its registered office at Dhundikhap, Post Dava-torang, Police Station Bagmundi, District Purulia, West Bengal 723152 and also having its another office at Village Chakaichalong, Post Office Kalimati, Police Station Bagmundi, District Purulia, West Bengal 723212 was formed in the year 1987 by the initiation of certain persons including Arabinda Bhattacharya, the Complainant herein for the objects of to promote the educational, social and economic upliftment and general welfare of the people, to establish and run educational institution with hostel facility for boys and girls separately, to render medical service etc.
- 8. That an Executive Committee was formed by the members of the Society wherein the Complainant was selected as Secretary. Till now your Petitioner serving as a Secretary of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra.
- 9. Your Petitioner states that being the Secretary the complainant use to discharge his duties sincerely and without blemishes since formation of the society. Your Petitioner totally devolved in the formation, running and day to day work of the society. The society runs benevolent projects for the weaker section of the society including running of two schools together with hostel facility, one at Dhundikhap and another at Village Chakaichalong, Post Office Kalimati under the name of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra.
- 10. That both the schools and hostels and other works were smoothly going on and also schools are growing day to day.
- 11. Your Petitioner further states that all of a sudden on 21/03/21 one of the Executive Committee members of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra namely Ashru Bhowmick, daughter of Late Dulal Chand Bhowmick, the Opposite Party No. (1) herein, along with some local hoodlums and lumpen illegally entered into the school premises at Dhundikhap and your Petitioner was also badly beaten by them. They used most filthy languages and they also threatened your Petitioner with dire consequences by saying that if he would enter the school premises at Dhundikhap once again, he would be killed by them. During that incidence your Petitioner somehow managed to make a phone call to the local Police Station,



Bagmundi and the officer of the local police station came at the place of incidence and rescued your Petitioner.

12. That in the mean time the mobile of the complainant was snatched by those hooligans before the police reached at the place of occurrence. Thereafter your Petitioner went to the local Police Station at Bagmundi for lodging an F.I.R. but the Officer-in-Charge advised me to inform the BDO, Bagmundi first. Your Petitioner went to the BDO, Bagmundi and the concerned BDO, Bagmundi forwarded the written complaint of your Petitioner to the local Police Station, Bagmundi and the said complaint was ultimately treated as General Diary, being GDE No. 172 dated 06/04/2021.

A copy of the said complaint bearing GDE No. 172 dated 06/04/2021 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter 'A'.


13. Your Petitioner further states that thereafter the Annual General Meeting of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra held on 22/08/2021 at Village Chakaichalong, Post Office Kalimati, Police Station Bagmundi, District Purulia, West Bengal – 723212, where it is unanimously resolved that the said Ashru Bhowmick, Opposite Party No. (1) herein, would be discharged from the post of Treasurer of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra and the same was informed to her and at present she is no more the Treasurer of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra.

A copy of the said Resolution of Annual General Meeting dated 22/08/2021 is annexed herewith and marked with the letter 'B'.

- 14. That once again on 03/11/2021 at 9:30 p.m. while your Petitioner was taking rest in school building at Dhundikhap, suddenly someone switched off the light from outside and locked the door of the room where your Petitioner stayed. On 04/11/2021 morning by the request of your Petitioner and with the help of some local people, who has broken the lock, your Petitioner able to come out from the room. Thereafter your Petitioner went to the local Police Station, Bagmundi but the Officer-in-Charge, Bagmundi PS. refused to take any complaint from your Petitioner.
- 15. That your Petitioner duly informed about the entire incident to the BDO, Bagmundi, verbally. Your Petitioner also requested him for providing security as the life of your Petitioner is in danger.



- That again on 07/11/2021 at 2:00 p.m. when your Petitioner was busy to do some official works in school building, Dhundikhap, suddenly your Petitioner heard the noise of lock-breaking. Your Petitioner have made a phone call to the Officer-in-Charge, Bagmundi PS., but he did not attend the same. Your Petitioner have also made phone call to the BDO, Bagmundi Block and gave him the information. Before your Petitioner become more vigilant the accused persons along with some other local hoodlums broken the lock of main gate and entered into the school premises illegally. Out of fear your Petitioner along with Teacherin-Charge Lakshmimani Murmu and Hostel-in-Charge Sushila Kuiri ran away and took shelter at the rooftop and locked the gate of rooftop but all of them accompanying by Ashru Bhowmick broken the lock of rooftop and take your Petitioner along with Lakshmimani Murmu and Sushila Kuiri out from rooftop to the ground floor brutally. Your Petitioner tried his level best to restrain them but they have beaten your Petitioner, also beaten Lakshmimani Murmu and Sushila Kuiri badly. They used most filthy languages and with dire consequences threaten your Petitioner and told that they would take force full possession over the school property and nobody can do anything against them.
- 17. Your Petitioner states that he along with Lakshmimani Murmu and Sushila Kuiri were badly injured and suffered immense physical pain and injury.
- 18. That they have stolen your Petitioner's mobile, Office seal of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra, Seal of Secretary of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra, also stolen some valuable books of Sushila Kuiri and some valuable items and articles of your Petitioner and of Sushila Kuiri. They also destroyed various official papers, office furnitures, broken the lock of room where your Petitioner use to stay and do his official work. At latter stage Police came and rescued your Petitioner, Lakshmimani Murmu and Sushila Kuiri and taken them to the Police Station, Bagmundi.
- 19. That immediately after that incidence your Petitioner along with the School-in-Charge namely Lakshimani Murmu and Hostel-in-Charge Sushila Kuiri want to lodge an F.I.R. about the incidence and against the Opposite Parties herein with the Bagmundi Police Station but unfortunately the Officer-in-Charge, Bagmundi PS. refused to receive any complaint against the Opposite Parties.
- 20. That your petitioner has also informed the same to the Superintendent of Police, Purulia but the S.P Purulia did not take any initiative of action against the



said act. In seeking assistance to restrain the opposite parties from doing such unauthorized and illegal activities for which your petitioner wants to take shelter before the appropriate court of law.

- 21. That there is a serious apprehension of breach of peace and public tranquility at the locale by the hands of opposite Parties.
- 22. Your petitioner apprehends danger to his own and to the lives of Lakshmimani Murmu and Sushila Kuiri and also apprehends danger to the School premises of Vivekananda Vikash Kendra by the hands of the opposite parties and their associates.
