Sub: Request for lodging F.I.R. against arrested accused namely Chitta Sing Sardar (35 yrs.) S/O- Lt. Negen Sing Sardar of Vill- Kulgora; PS- Hura, Dist.- Purulia.

Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested accused namely Chitta Sing Sardar (35 yrs.) S/O- Lt. Negen Sing Sardar of Vill- Kulgora, PS- Hura, Dist.- Purulia. I beg to state that today (30.12.2021), I was directed to find out whether the guidelines of Govt. regarding pandemic situation has been implanted properly at Hura PS area or not vide Hura P.S CC No – 3220/21 Dtd 30.12.2021 and while I along with C/959 Babu Ansary and HG/1781 Subhendu Sekhar Mahato. We reached at Kulgora More at about 18:15 hrs. that time we found that the above noted accrued person was moving at public place without wearing face musk. On being asked he disclosed his identity as noted above but he failed to give any satisfactory reason for his presence at public place without wearing face musk.

He violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media etc for prevention of attack from CORONA Virus/COVID-19. He was creating annoyance to the society & violated govt. /order. Though in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of India order No – 753/XV-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated – 30.11.2021 of the Government of West Bengal, Wearing of facial mask have been mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation, on violation of using mask and social distance norms should be strictly dealt with.

I arrested him for disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued arrest Memo. I informed him & his relative regarding the ground of arrest i.e. as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). A prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. All the process was done in between 18:25 to 18:35 hrs on 30.12.2021. There was every chance of breach of peace and requiring of offence if not arrested.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be lodged against the above noted arrested accd. namely Chitta Sing Sardar (35 yrs.) S/O- Lt. Negen Sing Sardar of Vill- Kulgora, PS- Hura, Dist.- Purulia who disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Quarantine rule U/S 188 IPC and Section 51(1) (b) National Disaster Management Act- 2005 and arrange for it's investigation.
