Sir,

I, Sekhar Kr Mitra, Inspector of Police, DEB, Purulia, do here by lodge complaint being produced the following seized articles viz (1) 27 (Twenty Seven) Pes domestic LPG cylinders of HP company fully loaded & sealed condition, (2) 17 (Seventeen) Pes domestic LPG empty cylinders of HP company (3) 01 (one) Pc domestic LPG cylinder fully loaded of Indane company (4) 03 (Three) Pes domestic LPG empty cylinder of Indane company (5) 10 (Ten) Pes small (approx 05 KG) cylinder fully loaded of HP company (6) 04 (Four) Pes small (approx 08 KG) empty cylinder of local made (7) 13 (Thirteen) Pes small (approx 05 KG) empty cylinder of local made (8) 08 (Eight) Pes small (approx 05 KG) empty cylinder of HP company (9) 07 (Seven) Pes commercial LPG empty cylinder of HP company (10) 06 (Six) Pes Nozzle device for the use of refilling from big cylinder to small cylinder, length approx 03 inch (11) 02 (Two) Pes Nozzle device for the use of refilling from big cylinder to small cylinder, length approx 08 inch (12) 01 (one) Pc Microtech Digital Weighing Scale Machine (Made in India) to the effect that today on 14.12.2021 on the basis of secret and credible information I, along with SI Amaresh Das, W/C 88 Pradyut Mandal, HG/1427 Benimadhab Char all of DEB Purulia had been to Jhalda PS and submitted one requisition to I/C Jhalda PS for rendering assistance for workout the credible information under the jurisdiction of Jhalda PS at 11:35 hrs. which has been noted in GD vide Jhalda PS GDE No. 616 dtd. 14.12.2021 at 11:45 hrs. Thereafter we along with officer and force of Jhalda PS (ASI Krishnapada Gorain with Force) left for Ichag market under Jhalda PS to work out the information. On arrival at Ichag market at about 14:35 hrs to work out the information and holding raid, search and seizure in the stationery shop of one Meghnath Mahato (32) S/O Lt. Lankesh Mahato of Vill- Mathari, PS-Jhalda, Dist Purulia. Prior to holding raid in the shop, we noticed huge nos. of domestic LPG cylinder kept inside the shop along with apparatus which is used for refilling LPG from one to another cylinder. The owner namely Meghnath Mahato was fled away from the shop on seeing police team. I noticed one person remain in the shop on asked he stated his name Amrit Nayak S/O Muruli Nayak of Vill- Ichag, PS-Jhalda, Dist-Purulia also stated that he is a worker of this shop. He was asked to produce valid documents / license for running his business in respect of possessing such domestic LPG cylinders and also such business of refilling, but he failed to produce any valid documents / license for running such illegal business. Thereafter myself along with accompanied officers and force held raid in the stationery shop of Meghnath Mahato (32) S/O Lt. Lankesh Mahato of Vill- Mathari, PS-Jhalda, Dist Purulia, after observing all formalities relating to search and seizure in between 15:00 hrs to 16:15 hrs.

As such I seized the articles as noted above with proper labeling in presence of public witnesses under proper seizure list from the shop of Meghnath Mahato from the possession of Amrit Nayak, worker of the shop.

Amrit Nayak failed to produce any valid documents / papers on behalf of shop owner Meghnath Mahato for running such business hence the owner Meghnath Mahato violated the provisions laid in rule 3 of West Bengal Cooking Gas (Licensing & Control order) 1985. Hence the owner has committed an offence punishable u/s 7(i)(a)(ii) of E.C.Act'1955.

In course of local enquiry it revealed that Owner Meghnath Mahato is running clandestine business of LPG Gas Cylinder and also selling LPG after refilling in other cylinder since long without having any authority or license and only for causing his wrongful gain and causing loss of revenue to the Govt.

The above noted seized articles as mentioned in S/L No. 01 to 09 left in Zimma to one office manager of M/S Ichag Indane Gramin Vitrak dealer namely Sachin Mahato of Vill-Jamlohar, PS-Jhalda, Dist.- Purulia vide his dealer code no. G/EC/WB/06/1989(G59971) in anticipation of kind approval of the Ld. CJM, Purulia Sadar Court.

I therefore request you to start a case u/s 7(i)(a)(ii) of E.C.Act'1955 against accused Meghnath Mahato (32) S/O Lt. Lankesh Mahato of Vill- Mathari, PS-Jhalda, Dist Purulia.

As per kind order of Dy. SP(DEB), Purulia ASI Swapan Chakroborty of DEB, Purulia will investigate the case.
