Sub: Request for lodging F.I.R. against arrested accused person 1) Rabi Agarwal (35 Yrs) S/O Prem Prasad Agarwal of Vill- Lower Beniasol, PS-Adra, Dist- Purulia & 10 others.

Sir,

In producing herewith 11 (Eleven) arrested accused persons namely (1) Rabi Agarwal (35 Yrs) S/O Prem Prasad Agarwal of Vill- Lower Beniasol (2) Dibendu Bauri (18 Yrs) S/O Biswanath Bauri of Vill-Beko (3) Amit Kumar Chakraborty (22 Yrs) S/O Ajoy Kr. Chakraborty of Young Market Rly. Qrt. NO-T/59 (4) Anubhaw Kumar (29 Yrs) S/O Sailendra Kumar of Rly. Qrt No- DS/104, Opposite Church School (5) Gopal Rajak (50 Yrs) S/O Mintu Rajak of Vill- Kantaranguni (6) Chinmoy Chowdhury (42 Yrs) S/O Lt. Hironmoy Chowdhury of Vill-Roguri (7) Pintu Mukharjee (49 Yrs) S/O Dubraj Mukharjee of Vill- Baghadabor, (8) Baneswar Bauri (20 Yrs) S/O Kartick Bauri of Vill- Barabagan, (9) Amit Bauri (20 Yrs) S/O Lt. Subal Bauri of Vill-Barabagan (10) Biswajit Bauri (21 Yrs) S/O Manik Bauri of Vill-Barabagan (11) Bikash Bauri (21 Yrs) S/O Jiban Bauri of Vill-Barabagan all are of PS-Adra, Dist-Purulia with all connected papers.

I beg to state that, today (19.01.2022), I was directed to find out whether the guidelines of Govt. regarding not wearing face musk in public and restriction of movement accept emergency from 22:00 hrs to next day 05:00 hrs in this pandemic situation has been implemented properly at Adra town area or not. Accordingly, I had been to Chatna More Adra, along with force vide Adra PS CC No-181/22 dtd.19.01.2022 at about 22.05 hrs and found that a gathering appeared at Chatna More. None of them was wearing face musk. On seeing Police party they have tried to escape from the grip of police party but eleven failed to escape due to efficiency effort of police party. On being asked they disclosed their identity as noted above.

They violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media etc for prevention of attack from CORONA Virus/COVID-19. Though in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 restriction of movement except emergency from 22:00 hrs to next day 05:00 hrs in the current pandemic disaster situation by restriction order No. Order No. 753/XX – ISS / 2M – 22/2020 Dated 15/01/2022 of Government of West Bengal. They are creating annoyance to the society & violated this govt. order.

I arrested them for disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued memo of arrest. I informed them & their relative regarding the ground of arrest provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). A prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. All the process was done at 22.35 hrs to 23.05 hrs. There was every chance of speared of Infection of disease COVID-19(CORONA VIRUS) which is endanger of human life.

Therefore, I pray, a specific case U/S 188/34 IPC and Section 51(1)(b) National Disaster Management Act- 2005 may kindly be lodge against 11 accused persons as noted above. As they disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases which is dangerous to lie and arrange for investigation.
