

Sub: Request for lodging F.I.R. against arrested accused namely 1) Bablu Mudi (45) S/O- Lt. Rabilochan Mudi of Vill- Tekchangora, PS- Hura, Dist.- Purulia 2) Bidhan Paul (24) S/O- Thulu Paul of Vill+PS- Hura, Dist.- Purulia 3) Chandi Charan Mahato (42) S/O- Nishakar Mahato of Vill- Napara, PS- Puncha, Dist.- Purulia.

Sir.

In producing herewith three arrested accused namely 1) Bablu Mudi (45) S/O- Lt. Rabilochan Mudi of Vill-Tekchangora, PS- Hura, Dist.- Purulia 2) Bidhan Paul (24) S/O- Thulu Paul of Vill+PS- Hura, Dist.- Purulia 3) Chandi Charan Mahato (42) S/O- Nishakar Mahato of Vill- Napara, PS- Puncha, Dist.- Purulia. I beg to state that today (08.01.2022), I was directed to find out whether the guidelines of Govt. regarding pandemic situation has been implanted properly at Hura PS area or not, vide Hura P.S Spl. CC No 02/22 Dtd 08.01.2022 and while I along with C/838 Rakhal Ch. Mahato, C/2721 Saheb Chand reached at Bishpuria More at about 16.05 hrs that time we found that the above noted three accused persons were moving at public place without wearing face musk or its alternative. On being asked they disclosed their identity as noted above but they failed to give any satisfactory reason for their presence at public place without wearing face musk or its alternative.

They violated the order duly promulgated by government through public servants and through media etc for prevention of attack from CORONA Virus/COVID-19. They were creating annoyance to the society & violated govt. /order. Though in view of Pandemic of COVID-19 outbreak vide Govt. of State order No – 753/XVII-ISS/2M-22/2020 dated – 02.01.2022 of the Government of West Bengal, Wearing of facial mask have been mandatory in public places in the current pandemic disaster situation, on violation of using mask and social distance norms should be strictly dealt with.

I arrested them U/S 41 Cr.PC for disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant after maintaining all rules of arrest, Issued arrest Memo. I informed them & their relative regarding the ground of arrest i.e. as per section 3 of the Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897, provide penalties for disobeying any regulation or order made under the Act. These are according to Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code (Disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant). A prima facie there were sufficient evidences to secure their detention. All the process was done in between 16.25 hrs to 17:25 hrs on 08.01.2022. There was every chance of breach of peace and requiring of offence if not arrested.

Therefore, I pray a specific case may kindly be lodged against the above noted arrested accused persons who disobeyed Govt. order and committed negligent Act likely to spread infection of diseases dangerous to life and violated Quarantine rule U/S 188 IPC and Section 51(1) (b) National Disaster Management Act- 2005 and arrange for its investigation.
